Headline Statistics

DYFED-POWYS POLICE

October 2004

Recorded Crime:

- Total Recorded Crime is up by **10%** (+1,862 crimes) compared to the same period last year (SPLY) to stand at **20,229** crimes (41.4 per 1,000 population). The monthly figure for October 2004 indicates that the effects of NCRS on increasing levels of recorded offences has stabilised. Monthly crimes for October 2004 (2,929) are up by 120 crimes on the same month in 2003.
- Recorded detection performance remains down, with the detection rate for the force at **39%** (7,928 detections) – with the volume decreasing by **9%** (-741 detections). This remains below the detection target of 50%.

Domestic Burglary:

- Domestic Burglaries are up by 105 crimes or **18%** compared to the previous year to stand at 709, with a detection rate of **22%** (157 detections). This is a decrease on the same period for the previous year (29%).
- The volume of detections has also fallen marginally by 26 (-14%). Pembrokeshire and Carmarthenshire are currently recording the highest detection rate at **23%** and **24%** respectively. Force crimes stood at 113 crimes (all domestic burglary offences) for the month of October 2004, an increase of 4 crimes on the same month in 2003.

Violent Crimes:

- Total Violent Crime is up by **15%** (+706 crimes) to stand at 5,562 crimes and a detection rate of 58% (down by 6% on SPLY). Levels of Serious Violent Crime (section 18,20 & 47) have increased compared with the same period last year (+4%) to stand at 2,576 crimes.
- The levels of offences during the month of October 2004 only fell by a notable margin with totals of Violent crime in October 2004 up by 3% on the same month in 2003 (from 756 to 776 offences).

Autocrime:

- Autocrime is up on the previous year (+**19%**/243 crimes) to stand at 1,516 with increases recorded in Ceredigion (up 29%/+18 crimes) and Pembrokeshire (up 65%/166 crimes). These increases counter marginally rising levels of autocrime now being recorded in Carmarthenshire (-2%/-10 crimes).
- Detection performance at **19%** (247 detections) is down on last year (29%) and below the 30% annual force target. In contrast to other categories the monthly number of offences saw a notable increase - recording 199 in the month of October 2004 – up 39% on the month of October 2003 (+66 offences).

Criminal Damage:

- Criminal Damage has recorded an increase of **32%** in April - October 2004 (+1,229 crimes) compared with the same period last year to stand at 5,093 crimes. In addition monthly offences for October 2004 stand at 744 offences, an increase of 24% on the month of October 2003 (+143 offences).
- The detection rate has decreased, against an increase in criminal damage offences, standing at **25%** (1,266 detections), compared with 29% for the previous year.

Drug Offences:

- Total Drug trafficking offences are down by **33%** compared with last year (down 53 offences to 111). Possession of Drug offences (including cannabis) is down **29%** for April - October 2004 compared with last year. In particular, recorded possessions are currently down by 51% in Powys.
- The number of offenders dealt with for trafficking class-A drugs stands at 94 (up from 53 for the period Apr-Oct last year) with 18 cocaine offenders (up from 6 last year), and Heroin offenders standing at 34 (up from 25 last year). The instances of drug seizure are down 29% (-537 seizures) on last year, with a total for April – October 2004 of 1,313 seizures.

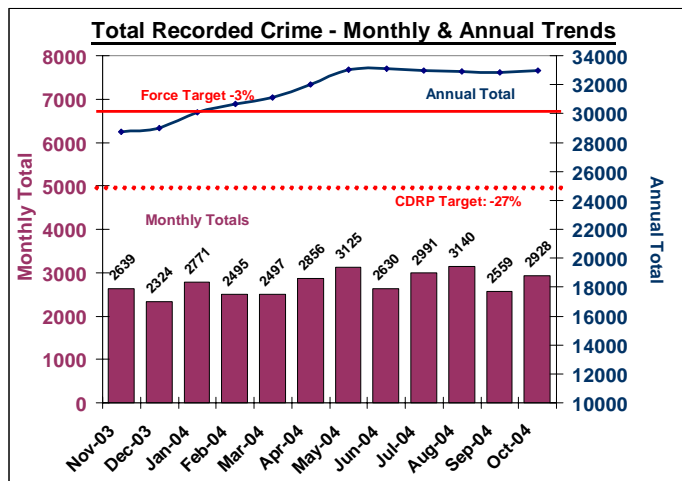
Recorded Crime - Annual Trends

Total recorded crime for April – October 2004 stands at 20,229 offences – a figure that is 10% (+1,862 crimes) higher than the same period last year.

As in previous months, the only division not recording a notable increase was Ceredigion where levels were unchanged. This compares with increases of 7% in Powys, 12% in Carmarthenshire and 17% in Pembrokeshire.

Monthly crimes for October 2004 (2,928) are up by 120 crimes on the same month in 2003.

In Carmarthenshire the increase in recorded monthly crimes was most dramatic – up by 8% on the same month in 2003.



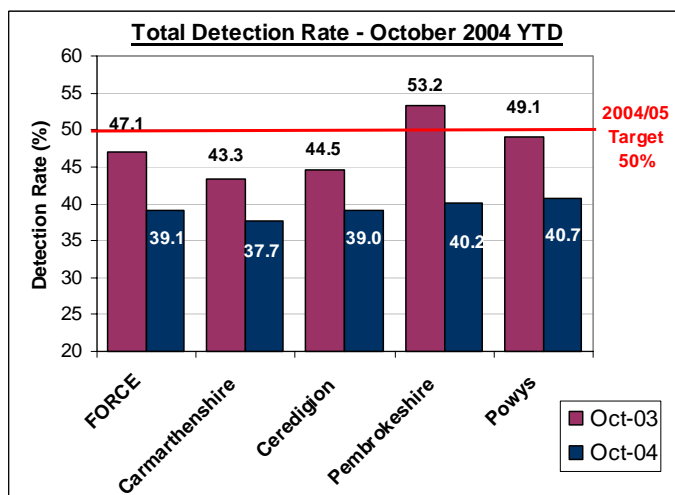
Detection Performance 2004/05

The current overall detection rate for 2004-05 is 39% - an apparent decrease on the 47% recorded for the same period last year.

As in previous months the volume of crimes detected is currently below the previous year – having decreased by 9% (-741 detections) to stand at 7,928 detections during April - October 2004.

The divisions continue to show only a slight variation in performance with all standing between 38% and 41%. Apparent performance in Pembrokeshire is notable as the scale of reduction is from 53% for the same period last year.

The monthly detection rate for October 2004 stands at 41% compared with 44% for the same month in 2003. All the divisions recorded a notable reduction in monthly detection performance.

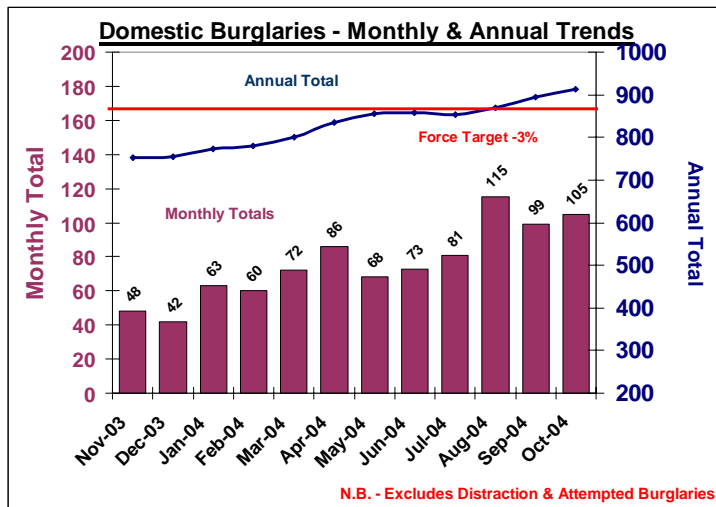

Recorded Crime - Annual Trends

The total recorded domestic burglaries for 2004-05 currently stands at 709 crimes for the period April-October, an increase of 18% (+105 crimes) compared to the same period last year.

As in previous months the variation in divisional performance remains – with Pembrokeshire recording a 56% increase (+63 crimes) in contrast to the decrease of 15% (-15 crimes) recorded in Ceredigion.

The monthly figures for October 2004 are recording a notable increase on the same month last year at 113 offences – an increase of 4 (+4%) on the same month in 2003.

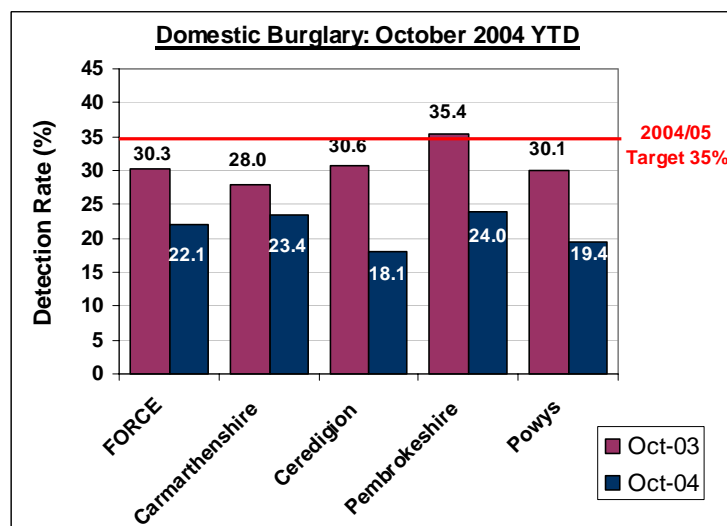


Detection Performance 2004/05

A detection rate of 22% is currently being recorded for the period April-October 2004, compared with 29% for the previous year. The volume of detections is down by 26 (-14%) to stand at 157 detections for the period.

Although subject to wide variations it is worth noting that the monthly detection performance for October stands at 17% compared with 29% for October 2003.

All the divisions show a decrease in performance (Apr-Oct) compared with the previous year. However, Carmarthenshire and Pembrokeshire (23% and 24%) retain the highest levels - although below the target of 35%.



Distraction Burglaries 2004/05

Recorded levels of distraction burglaries stand at 9 crimes (two detected) for the period April – October 2004, which is sixteen fewer than during the same period last year. These offences were committed in Carmarthenshire (4), Powys (3), and Pembrokeshire (2).

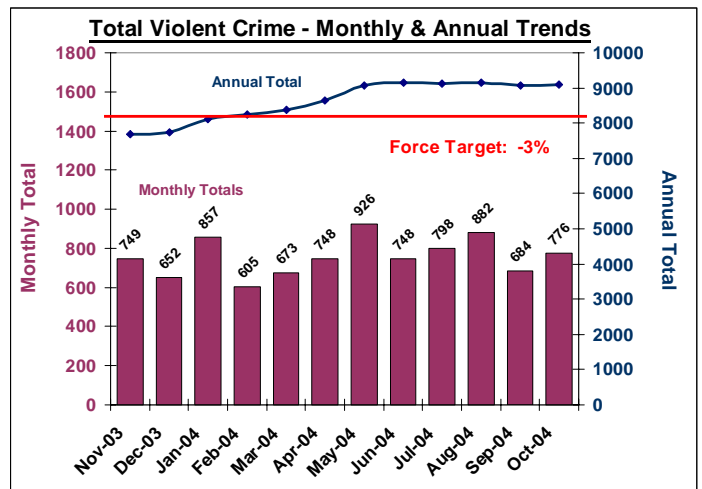
Total Violent Crime - Annual Trends

Total crimes for 2004–05 year-to-date (April-October) stand at 5,562 offences, an increase of 706 offences (+17%) compared with this time the previous year (April – October 2003).

Rates of increase vary, with a relatively large rise in Carmarthenshire of 20% (up 346 crimes) compared with little change in Ceredigion (up by 40 offences).

The number of sexual offences is recorded as 336 crimes for the period Apr-October - an increase of 83 offences (+32%) on the same period last year. Robberies stand at 22 offences – down by 8 on last year.

The levels of offences during the month October 2004 are recording a notable reduction on the same month in 2003 – with levels up 31% (from 756 – 776 offences).



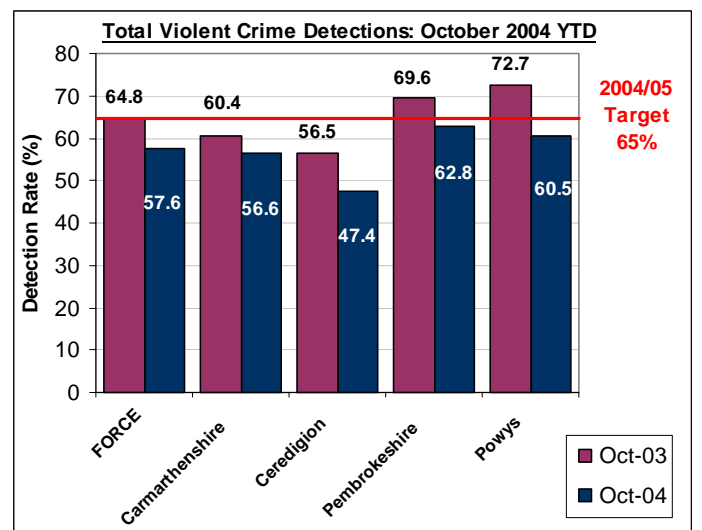
Detection Performance 2004/05 (April – October)

The detection performance stands at 58% for 2004-05. This is an apparent reduction on the on the 64% recorded for the same period last year and below the established target of 65%.

The actual volume of detections recorded is up by 2% (+58 detections) compared with the same period last year to stand at 3,205 detected violent crimes.

At divisional level Pembrokeshire and Powys are recording levels consistent with the target of 65% - but all record an apparent falling detection performance. Ceredigion and Powys record the largest reduction in detection - falling by 12% and 7% respectively.

Monthly detection performance for October 2004 stands at 56% - down from 62% in the month of October 2003.

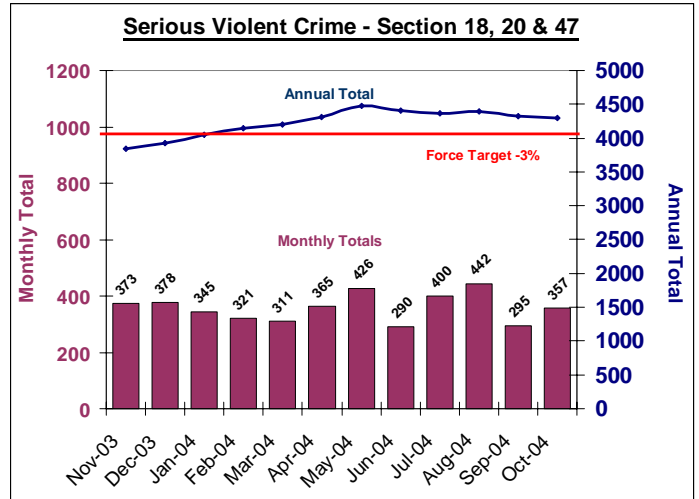
Serious Violent Crime – Sections 18, 20 & 47

This category includes assault and wounding offences covered by sections 18, 20 and 47, but excludes the crime category - common assaults. Total offences stand at 2,576 for the period April - October 2004, an increase of 4% (+103 offences) on the previous year.

This is attributable to increases in Carmarthenshire and Pembrokeshire - up by 10% and 17% respectively. In contrast Powys is recording a 3% reduction with a 4% reduction recorded in Ceredigion.

The numbers of offences during the month of October 2004 stand at 358 – a 6% reduction on the same month in 2003 (379 offences).

Although monthly offence levels are prone to wide variations, this remains an indication that medium term trends in offences are stabilising after a period of steady increase.



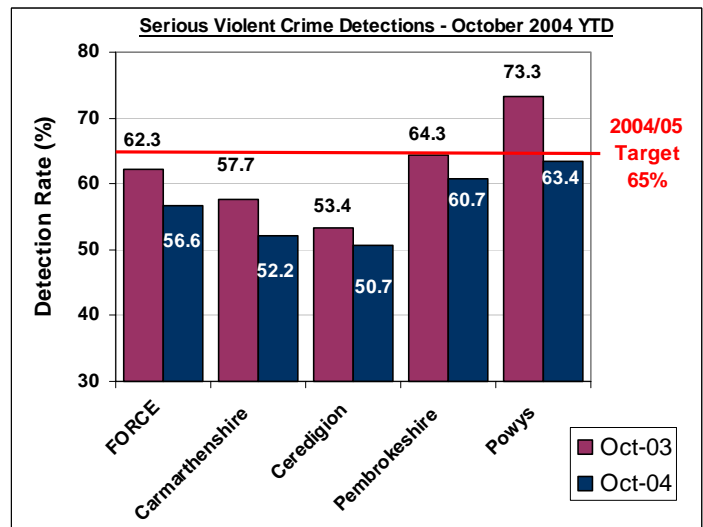
Detection Performance 2004/05 - Oct 2004 YTD

The period April – October 2004 records a detection rate of 57% for serious violent crime, compared to 63% achieved during the same period last year.

This fall in apparent detection performance is set against a fall in the volume of detections recorded – down by 88 detected offences (-6%) to stand at 1,457 for the period.

The fall in detection rate in Ceredigion and Powys is compounded by the notable increase in offences currently recorded in those areas. This is in contrast to the position in Pembrokeshire where both the detection and reduction target are being attained.

Detection rates for serious violent crimes remain characteristically lower than those for total violent crime across the divisions.

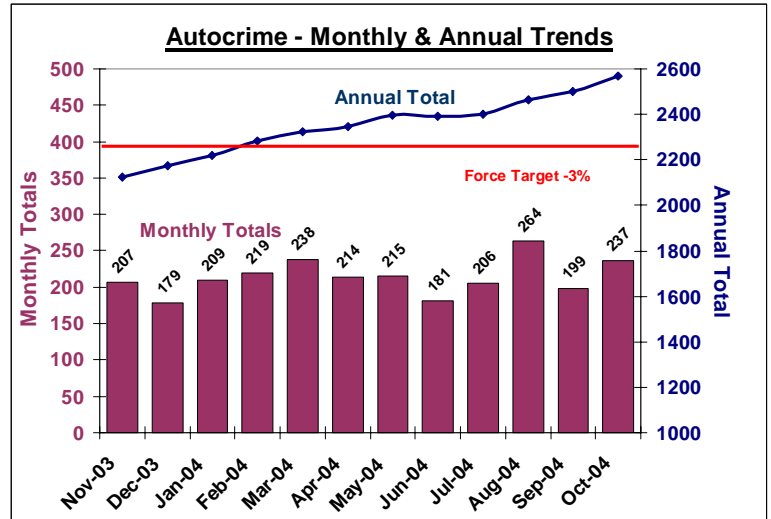
Autocrime - Annual Trends

Total offences stand at 1,516 for the period April - October 2004, an increase of 19% (+243 offences) on the previous year.

This is attributable to increases in Pembrokeshire - currently recording a 65% (+166 offences) on the same period last year.

This increase is supplemented by a 29% increase in Ceredigion offences while in contrast Carmarthenshire offences are recording a small reduction (down by 18 offences or 3%).

In addition, the monthly number of offences saw a notable increase - recording 237 in the month of October 2004 – up 39% on October 2003 (+66 offences).



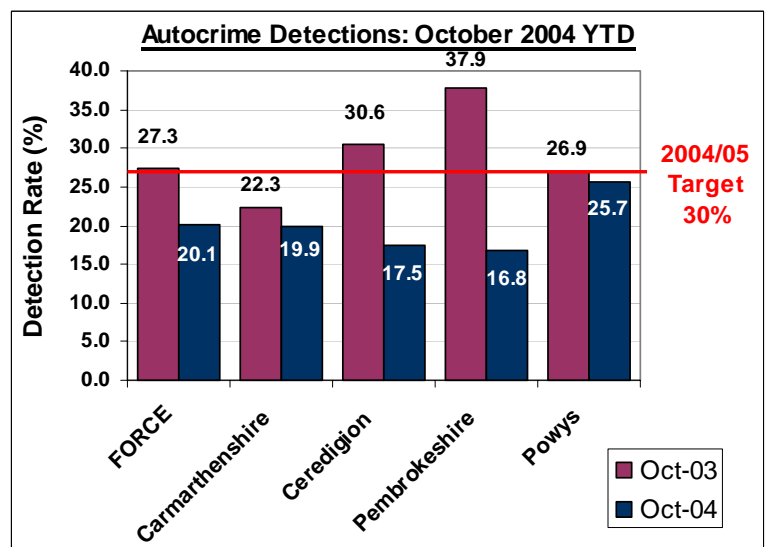
Detection Performance 2004/05

Detection performance stands at 20% for April - October 2004. This is below the target of 30% and a decrease on the 27% recorded for the same period last year.

This has been compounded over recent months by the fact that the volume of detections recorded has also fallen by nearly a quarter over the period (-12% or 43 detections).

Recorded performance across the force is recording substantial reductions in detection rate – with Pems seeing rates fall from 38% last year to 17% for the period April-October 2004.

Powys is notable in recording the smallest apparent reduction in the detection rate from 27% last year to 26% this year.

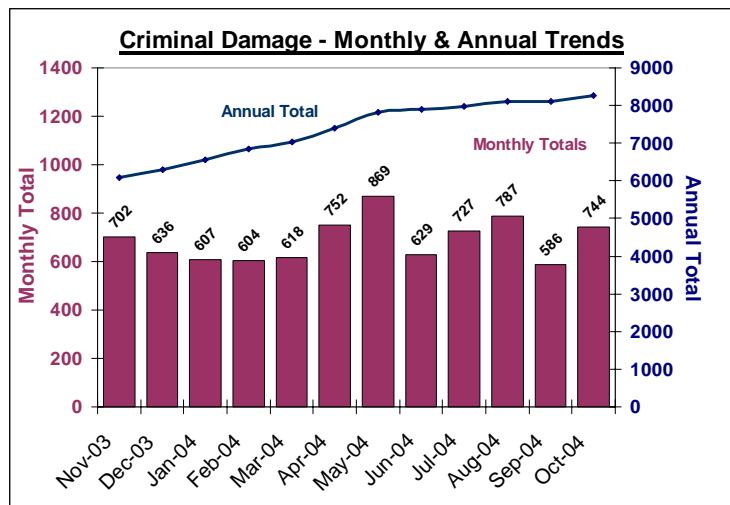

Criminal Damage - Annual Trends

A total 5,093 offences were recorded in April – October 2004, an increase of 32% in criminal damage offences (+1229 offences) compared with last year.

Increases in recorded totals remain evident across the force area, up 44% in Powys and 36% in Pembrokeshire, compounded by increases of 34% in Carmarthenshire and 4% in Ceredigion.

In addition monthly offences for October 2004 are broadly stable, standing at 744 offences, an increase of 24% on the same month in 2003 (602 offences).



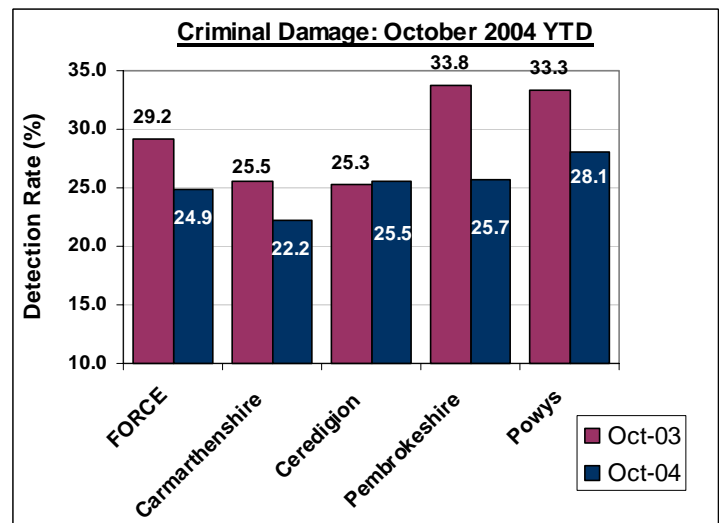
Detection Performance 2004/05

The detection rate has fallen from the previous year – standing at 25% for April - October 2004 compared with 29% for the same period last year.

Reflecting this increase, the volume of detections has correspondingly risen by 12% this year (136 more detections) to stand at 1,266 detections for the period April – October 2004.

Pembrokeshire continues to record the most pronounced reduction in recorded detection performance – down from 34% to 26%. Similarly Ceredigion remains notable in recording a slight increase from 25% – 26%.

Monthly detection performance remains broadly unchanged - standing at 23% (171 detected offences) for the month of October 2004 compared with 24% for October 2003.

Scientific Support Unit (SSU)

Scientific Support Unit (SSU) Function

The unit assists the collation and preservation of fingerprint, photographic and other forensic evidence. Following arrival at the unit the material is checked and recorded at the administration section and from here is distributed to the appropriate section within the unit.

The total number of recorded identifications for the period April-October 2004 stand at 251 - a fall of 31% (-113) on the same period last year. Correspondingly, the number of suspect searches has fallen by 32% over the period.

Of the total number of identifications for the period April-October 2004, Scientific Support Officers (SSO) completed 74%, - this compares with 74% for the same period last year. The remainder of ID's are Scene Examiner related.

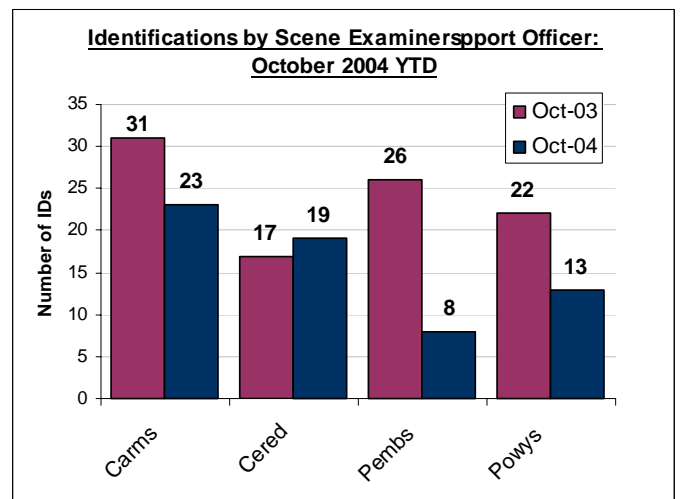
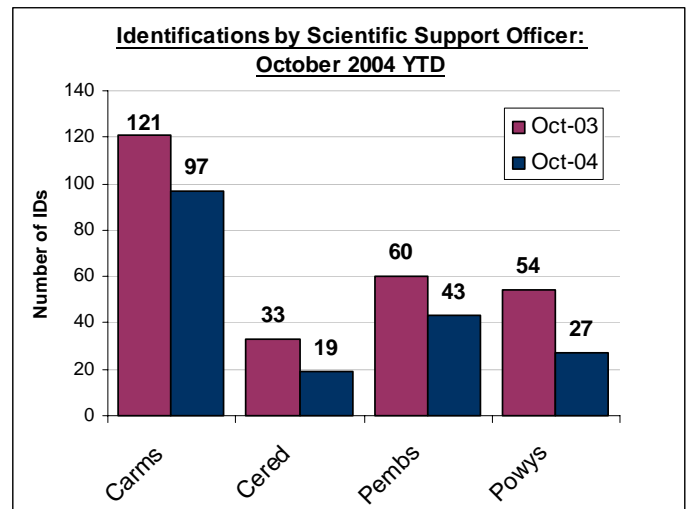
Performance for 2004-05

The total number of fingerprint development unit identifications conducted (FDU) stands at 141 for the year-to-date (178 last year) - this represents 56% of the total number of ID's (this figure was the same last year).

The total number of DNA matches is broadly unchanged - down from 286 to 247 (down 5%) - with the number of out-of-force matches also similar at 195 (down 7% on the previous year). In contrast the number of forensic submissions are up by 9% on the previous year (from 459 to 500).

A total of 2,384 CJ samples have been received at HQ (down by 29% on period last year) - of which 92% have been sent to a laboratory for further tests. This compares with 84% for the same period last year.

As reported previously the number of rejected samples has reduced from 18 to 9. It is worth re-iterating that a number of individuals can be involved with these processes.

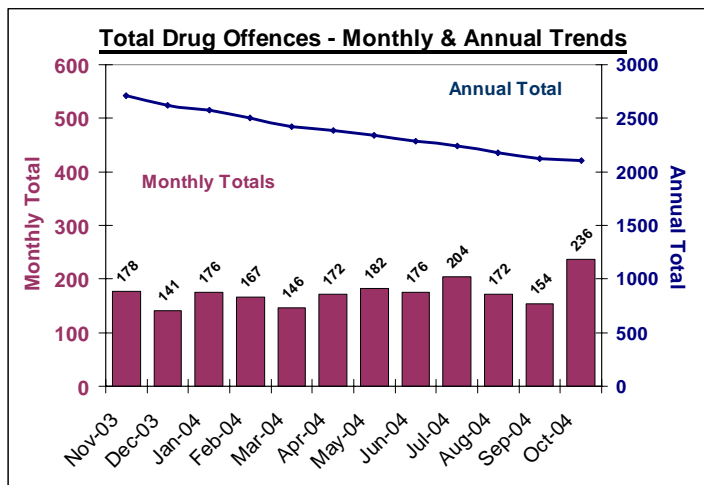
April – October 2004

All Drug Offences

The number of total drug offences for April - October 2004 stand at a total of 1296 – a 19% fall (-310 crimes) on the same period last year.

Performance at divisional level continues to show sharp variation with decreases of 48% in Powys, 19% in Carmarthenshire and 16% in Pembrokeshire.

These contrast notably with a 12% increase in Ceredigion (although this equates to an increase of only 27 offences). Trafficking offences have fallen by 33% over the period.



Drug Trafficking & Possession (2004 YTD)

- The current level of 'Trafficking in Controlled Drugs' offences stands at 111 for the period April – October 2004, a fall of 33% (-53 offences) on the same period last year.
- 'Possession of Cannabis' and 'Other Drug Possession' have fallen collectively by 21% with 1135 recorded during April–October 2004, a decrease of 305 offences. It is again notable that collective drug/Cannabis possessions in Powys are down by a nearly half this year (-51%).
- **Class A drugs (April – October 2004):**
 - The 111 trafficking offences recorded during April - October 2004, relate to 99 individual offenders (there are more offences than offenders since they may be jointly charged for the same offence).
 - There were a total of 94 offenders charged for trafficking Class-A drugs, and increase of 41 offenders on the 53 recorded for the same period last year (+77%). There have been 18 offenders charged with trafficking Cocaine (compared to 6 last year) while Heroin offenders charged now stands at 34, (up from 25 for the same period last year). Ecstasy offenders currently stand at 36 – up from 19 the previous year.

Drug Seizures

- As reported previously over previous months there is a recorded fall in the instances where drugs are seized reported during with a 29% reduction in April – October 2004 compared with the previous year (down from 1850 to 1313). While instances of seizure remain a rough measure there is also a recorded reduction in total weight and value of drugs seized.

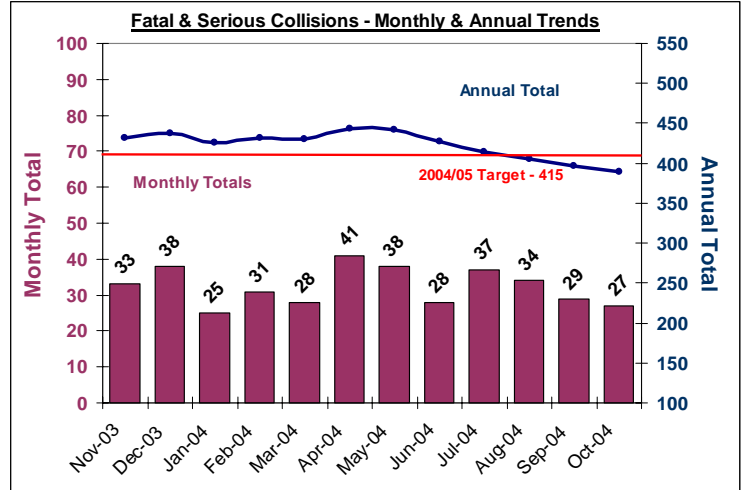
Serious and Fatal Collisions – Annual Trends

The total level of fatal collisions currently stands at 27 for April - October 2004, 5 more than the number recorded during the same period last year.

The total levels of serious and fatal collisions currently stand at 249 for April - October 2004, down by 9% on the previous year (26 fewer collisions). This is consistent with the pro-rata target for the period of 0.5 per 1,000 population.

The year ending October 2004 is currently recording a provisional total of 389 serious and fatal collisions – a 11% fall (-46 collisions) on the preceding 12-month period.

As in previous months, fatal and serious collisions have reduced by 23% in Powys and 9% in Pembrokeshire. Levels in other areas are broadly stable.

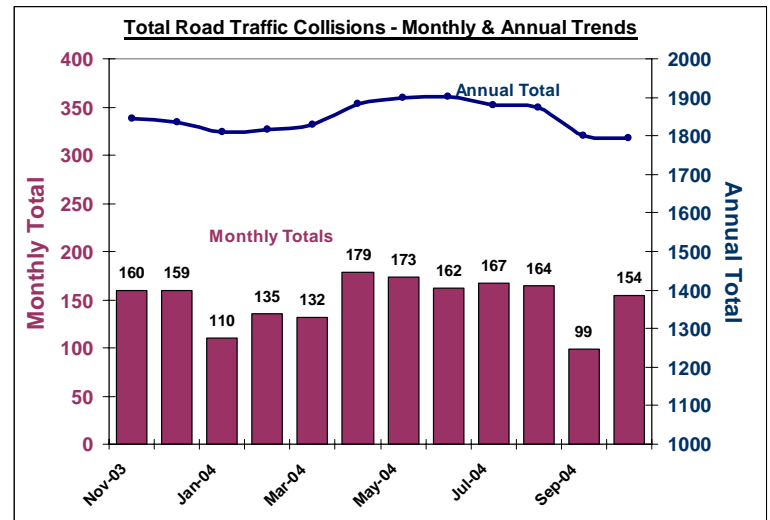


Total Road Traffic Collisions – Annual Trends

The total number of collisions (including slight) recorded during April - October 2004 stands at 1,159 – a rise of 2% (25 fewer collisions) on the same period last year.

In Carmarthenshire totals stand at 385 collisions, while totals in Pembrokeshire are down 9% (-5 collisions).

Total force area collisions for the year ending October 2004 stand at 1,794 - a fall of 2% on the preceding 12-month period (although final monthly figures are likely to negate this reduction).

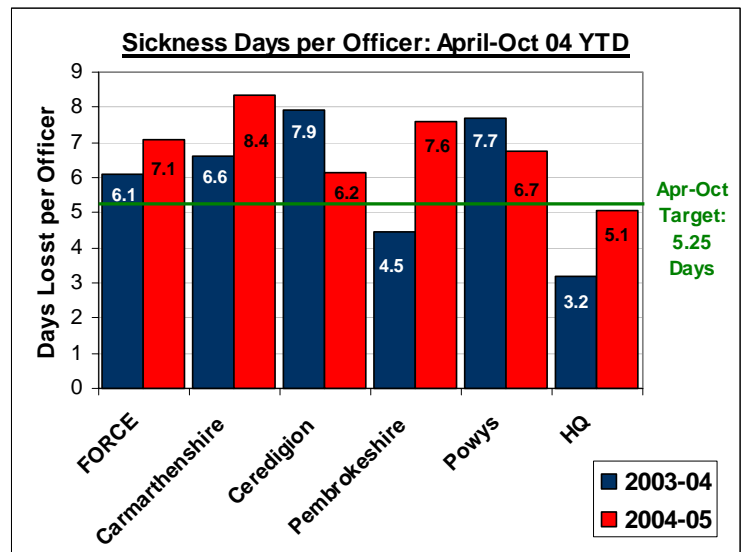
Officer Sickness Levels YTD

Sickness levels for the year stand at 7.1 days per officer (8405.5 days) representing an increase of 18% on the previous year. This is an increase of 1300 total days compared with the previous year total (7105.5 days or 6.1 days per officer).

The force figure has exceeded the established target of 5.25 days for April – October 2004.

Among the divisions, Ceredigion has recorded a reduction in sickness from 7.9 days to 6.2 days per officer and a reduction of 20% in the total number of days.

At the moment Pembrokeshire is recording the greatest increase, with sickness up to 7.6 days per officer (total days up by around 70%).

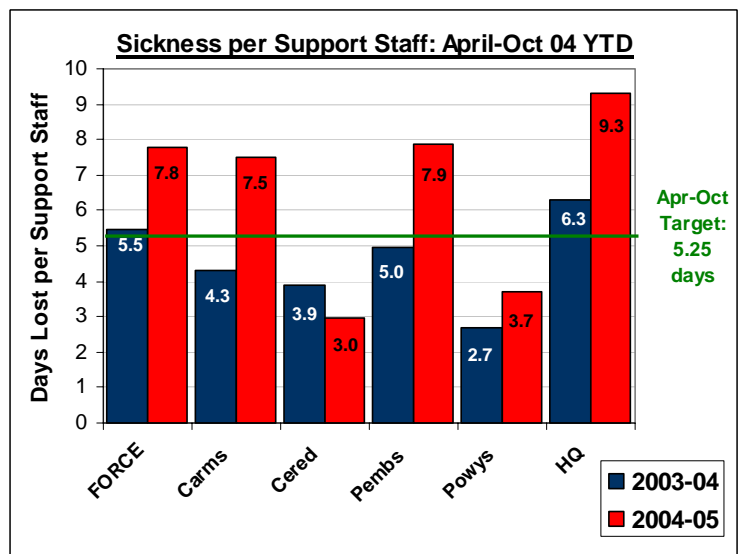


Police Staff Sickness Levels YTD

The level of recorded sickness stands at 7.80 days per police staff member for the period April – October 2004. This is also some way from the established target of 5.25 days per staff member for the period.

Similarly this is an increase on the 5.46 days recorded for the same period last year. The total number of sickness days recorded stands at 4,622.5 – up by 59% on the previous year.

The lowest current levels of police staff sickness stand at 3.0 days in Ceredigion and 3.7 in Powys. However Carmarthenshire recorded an increase of 82% in days (306 last year, and 558.5 this period).

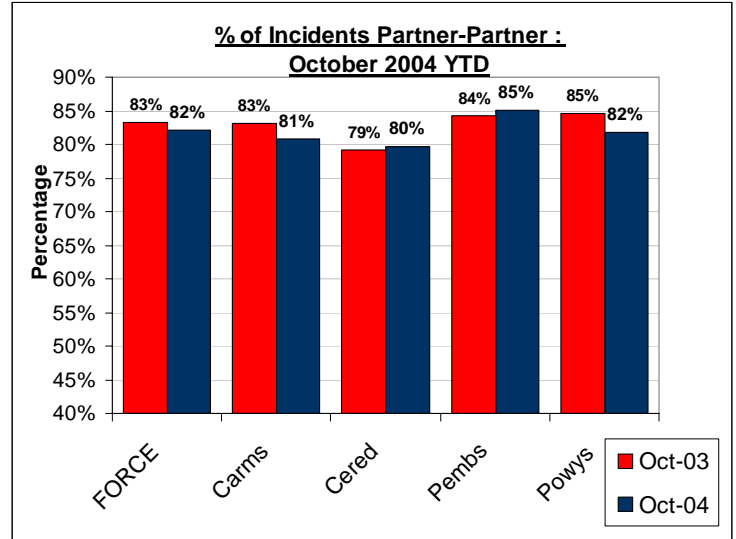

The total incidents recorded stands at 2,328 incidents for the period April-October 2004 – a 5% increase on the same period last year (+107 incidents).

Similarly, the total level of arrests arising from these incidents has fallen by 9% to stand at 689 (compared with 758 last year). The % of arrests where a power of arrest occurs is stable at 80% (this is the same as last year).

The proportion of incidents attributable to partner-partner (both current and former) conflict stands at 82% - a decrease on the 83% last year. In addition, the volume of partner related incidents has changed slightly, having increased by 61 incidents over the period.



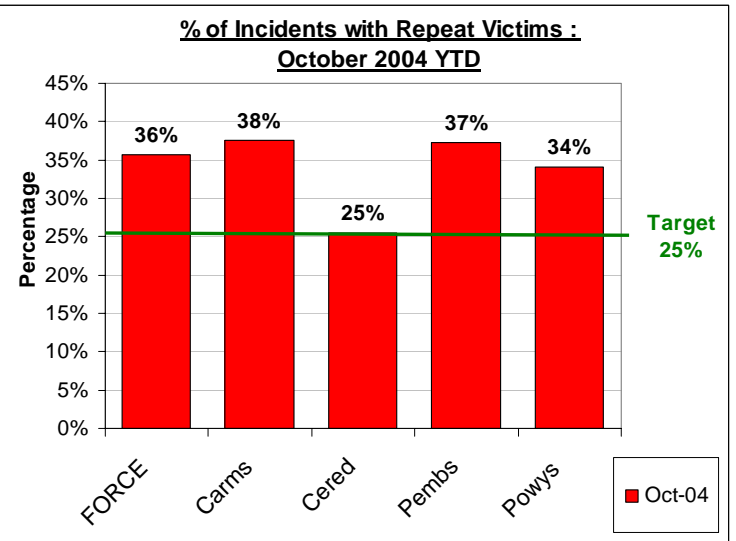
Total Repeat Domestic Incidents: Oct 2004 YTD

Among the total incidents recorded during the period April-October 36% of these involved persons who have been a victim at some other point during the preceding 12-months (approx 829 incidents).

This is slightly higher than same period last year, with repeat rate up from 31% to 36%.

Performance at divisional level remains characteristically lowest in Ceredigion at 25% - consistent with the desired target level of 25%.

Approximate data for the same period last year suggests increases in repeat victimisation are most pronounced in Carmarthenshire and Pembrokeshire.

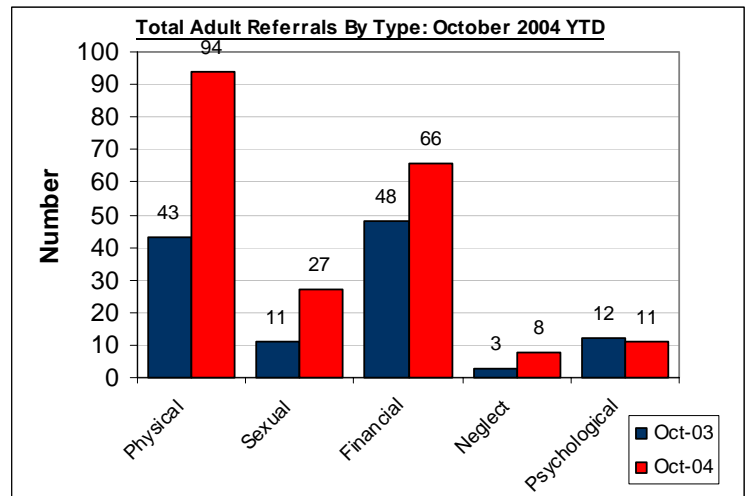
Child Referrals – October 2004 YTD

The total numbers of child referrals for April - October 2004 stands at 910, a 23% reduction on the previous year (although current data is provisional pending data from Aberystwyth).

The majority of these referrals (73%) were for the protection of the child due to a perceived physical or sexual risk.

The number of victims interviewed on video currently stands at 190 – a level down by 18 interviews compared with same period last year.

The numbers of children detained for protection (under s. 46) stands at 128 - a reduction of 32% on the previous year.



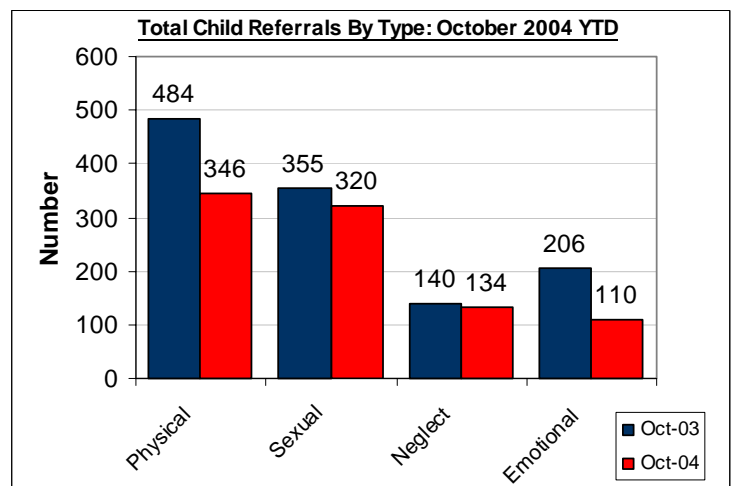
Adult Referrals & ABE - October 2004 YTD

Levels of adult referral remain lower, now recording a total of 206 for the year to date – up from 117 for the same period last year.

Physical threat remains the most common reason for adult referral – at 46% (up from 37% for the same period last year).

The numbers of witness interviews (consistent with Achieving Best Evidence) recorded on video are continuing to record a notable increase.

Adult witness video interviews have increased from 32 to 48, and child witness video interviews have increased from 154 to 181 for the same period last year.

Anti-Social Behaviour Orders –October 2004 YTD

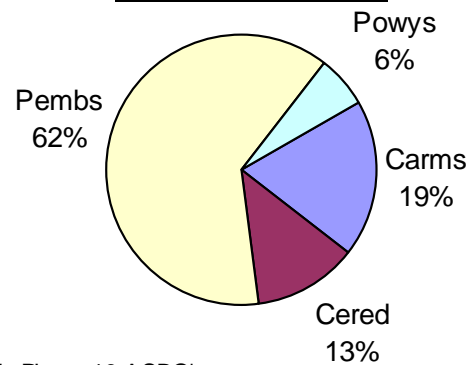
For the purposes of obtaining an ASBO the definition of anti-social behaviour requires that the defendant must be shown to have behaved in an anti-social manner and that an order is necessary for the protection of persons from further anti-social behaviour by the defendant.

There are currently a total of 16 individuals who currently have an ASBO in the force area – 1 down from last month.

Of these ASBO's – 11 were due to drunkenness in a public place and of the total 5 have subsequently been convicted of breaching their order.

Please note the ASBO is not currently a record of anti-social behaviour or its severity, but rather a measure of the frequency that a specific legal action is applied.

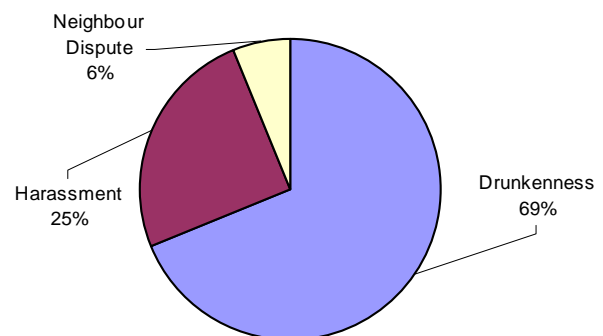
Public Disorder – Fixed Ticket Penalties

The total number of fixed penalties issued for public disorder stands at 205 – an average of 51 in each of the four months of operation.

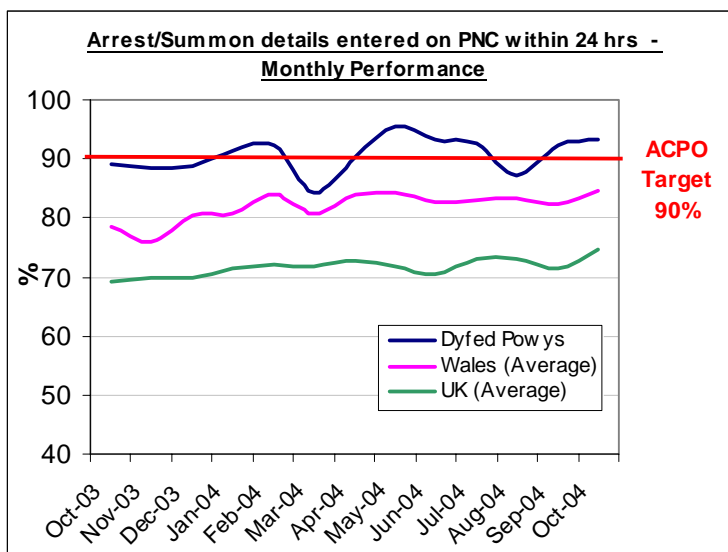
Arrest/Summons Details on PNC - Monthly

The speed at which details of arrest and summons in Dyfed Powys are entered on PNC is averaging about 88% within 24 hrs during the period April-Oct 2004.

The monthly figure for October 2004 was at 93% - the highest monthly rate so far this financial year.

The monthly performance remains higher than the Welsh and UK monthly average (85% and 75% respectively) as it has been for some months.

The number of reports entered stands at a total of 6,373 for April-October 2004 – a reduction of 14% on the same period last year. This compares with an 6% increase in Wales and 13% increase across the UK.

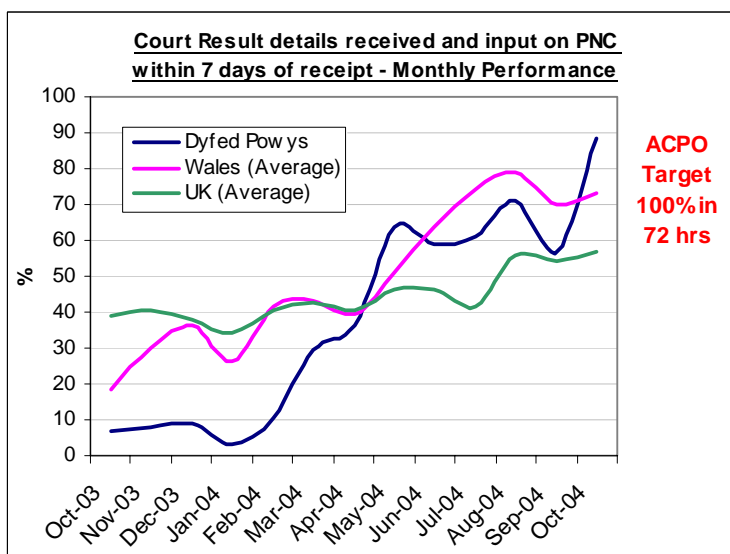


Court Result Details on PNC - Monthly

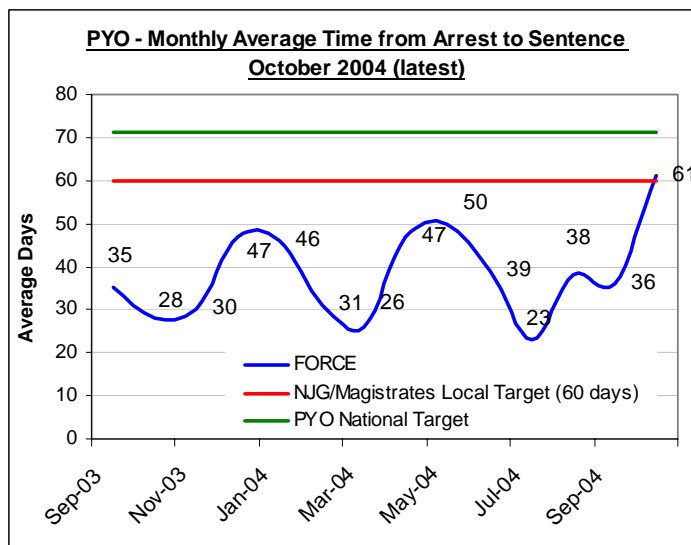
Persistent Young Offenders – October 2004

This section is aimed at providing performance information relating to the 'Narrowing the Justice Gap' (NJG) agenda and the number of offences brought to justice.

Monthly performance currently recorded for August 2004 stands at an average period of 61 days from arrest of persistent young offender to time of sentence.

This data remains provisional – but this is the first monthly level for many months that is outside of the local criminal justice board of 60 days, but remains within the national target of 71 days.

Although case levels differ markedly, the time to completion during October was recorded as highest in Aberystwyth and Ammanford (79 days and 74 days respectively).



Offences Brought to Justice & NJG Performance

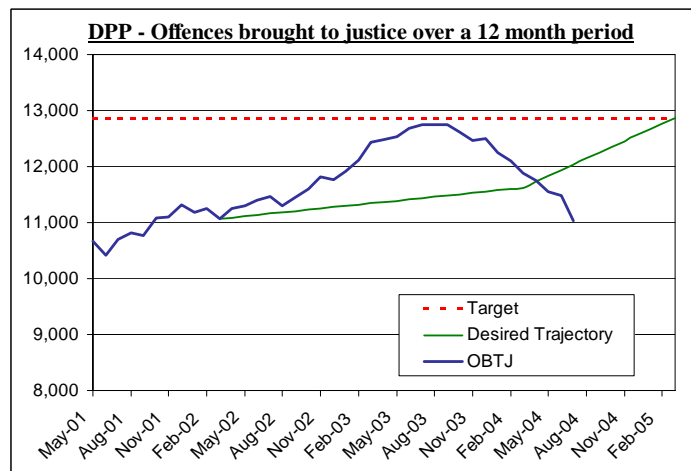
In 2001/02 a total of 11,068 offences were brought to justice (OBTJ), representing an attrition rate of 46.2%. In 2003/04 a total of 11,848 offences were brought to justice – an attrition rate of 38% on the 31,105 offences recorded.

The figure for the period April 2003 – July 2004 (the most recently available 12-months' data) illustrates an attrition rate of 33.5%.

It represents a 0.3% reduction compared with the baseline year, against a target of a 16% increase by the end of 2004/05.

Other NJG performance measures are illustrating a monthly ineffective trial rate for crown courts at 9% for the year ending August 2004 (target 12%), and for magistrates courts at 10% (target 23%).

File quality targets are also being met. The force monthly figure for August 2004 stands at 87%, with year to date (Apr-August – latest) at 89% - ahead of the established target of 85% for 2004/05.

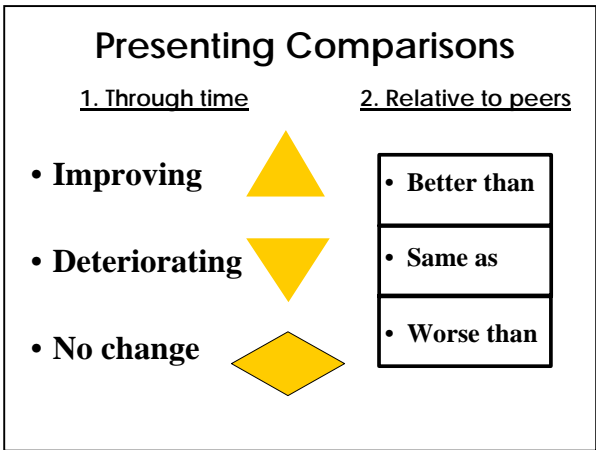
