CRIME TRENDS UPDATE November 2004

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Headline Statistics

DYFED-POWYS POLICE

November 2004

Recorded Crime:

- Total Recorded Crime is up by **8%** (+1,763 crimes) compared to the same period last year (SPLY) to stand at **22,751** crimes (46.6 per 1,000 population). The monthly figure for November 2004 stands at 2,522 – a notable reduction of 4% (-94 offences) on the same month in 2003.
- Recorded detection performance remains down, with the detection rate for the force at **39%** (8,925 detections) – with the volume decreasing by **8%** (-826 detections). This remains below the detection target of 50%.

Domestic Burglary:

- Domestic Burglaries are up by 106 crimes or **16%** compared to the previous year to stand at 770, with a detection rate of **22%** (168 detections). This is a decrease on the same period for the previous year (30%).
- The volume of detections has also fallen marginally by 32 (-8%). Pembrokeshire and Carmarthenshire are currently recording the highest detection rate at **24%** and **23%** respectively. Force crimes stood at 61 (all domestic burglary offences) for the month of November 2004, unchanged from the month of November in 2003.

Violent Crimes:

- Total Violent Crime is up by **11%** (+640 crimes) to stand at 6,230 crimes and a detection rate of 58% (down by 6% on SPLY). Levels of Serious Violent Crime (section 18,20 & 47) have remained unchanged at (+1%) compared with the same period last year to stand at 2,883 crimes.
- The levels of offences during the month of November 2004 again fell by a notable margin with totals of Violent crime in November 2004 down by 8% on the same month in 2003 (from 731 to 669 offences).

Autocrime:

- Autocrime is up on the previous year (+15% or 218 crimes) to stand at 1,698 with increases recorded in Ceredigion (up 20%/+31 crimes) and Pembrokeshire (up 39%/183 crimes). These increases counter marginally falling levels being recorded in Carmarthenshire (-2%/-14 crimes).
- Detection performance at **20%** (337 detections) is down on last year (26%) and below the 30% annual force target. The monthly number of offences saw a notable fall in November - with 182 recorded - down 12% (-25 offences) on the same month in 2003.

Criminal Damage:

- Criminal Damage has recorded an increase of **25%** in April - November 2004 (+1,156 crimes) compared with the same period last year to stand at 5,722 crimes. In addition monthly offences for November 2004 stand at 629 offences, a fall of 10% on the month of November 2003 (-73 offences).
- The recorded detection rate has decreased against an increase in criminal damage offences, currently standing at **25%** (1,406 detections), compared with 28% for the previous year.

Drug Offences:

- Total Drug trafficking offences are down by **30%** compared with last year (down 52 offences to 124). Possession of Drug offences (including cannabis) is down **16%** for April - November 2004 compared with last year. In particular, recorded possessions are currently down by 52% in Powys.
- The number of offenders dealt with for trafficking class-A drugs stands at 120 (up from 56 for the period Apr-Nov last year) with 19 cocaine offenders (up from 6 last year), and Heroin offenders standing at 43 (up from 26 last year). The instances of drug seizure are down 25% (-511 seizures) on last year, with a total for April – November 2004 of 1,538 occurrences of drug seizure.

Total Recorded Crime

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Local Target 2004/05 – 3% reduction. CDRP Target – a 27% reduction (23,043 crimes) to attain CDRP target. 50% detection rate

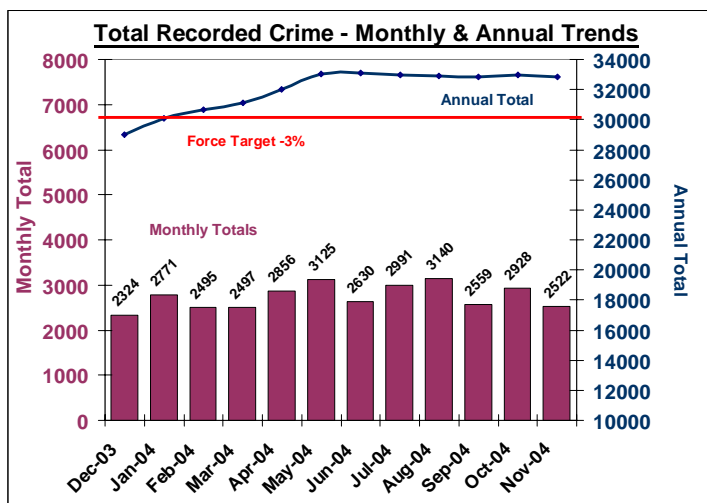
Recorded Crime - Annual Trends

Total recorded crime for April – November 2004 stands at 22,751 offences – a figure that is 8% (+1,763 crimes) higher than the same period last year.

As in previous months, the only division not recording a notable increase was Ceredigion where levels were largely unchanged. This compares with increases of 6% in Powys, 9% in Carmarthenshire and 16% in Pembrokeshire.

Monthly crimes for November 2004 (2,522) are down by 94 crimes on the same month in 2003 (-4%).

In Carmarthenshire the decrease in recorded monthly crimes was most dramatic – down by 9% on the same month in 2003.



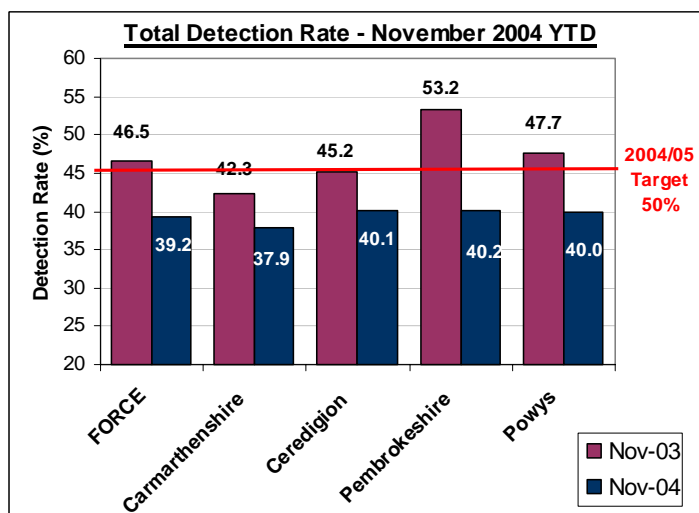
Detection Performance 2004/05

The current overall detection rate for 2004-05 is 39% – an apparent decrease on the 47% recorded for the same period last year.

As in previous months the volume of crimes detected is currently below the previous year – having decreased by 8% (-826 detections) to stand at 8,925 detections during April - November 2004.

The divisions continue to show only a slight variation in performance with all standing between 38% and 40%. Apparent performance in Pembrokeshire is notable as the scale of reduction is from 53% for the same period last year.

The monthly detection rate for November 2004 stands at 38% compared with 41% for the same month in 2003.

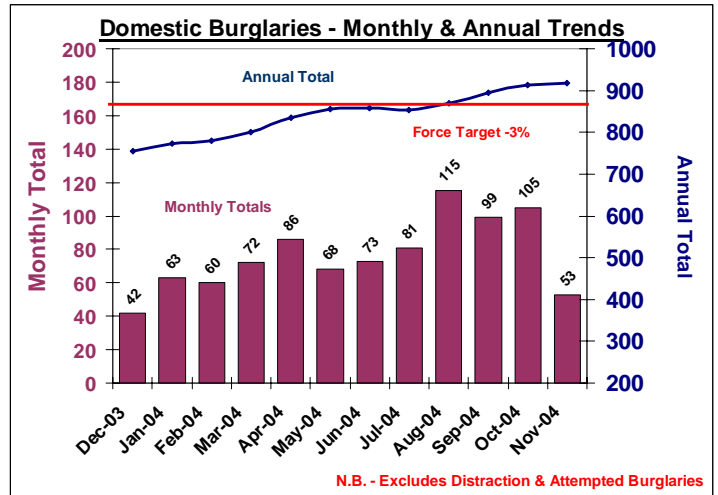

Recorded Crime - Annual Trends

The total recorded domestic burglaries for 2004-05 currently stands at 770 crimes for the period April-November, an increase of 16% (+106 crimes) compared to the same period last year.

As in previous months the variation in divisional performance remains – with Pembrokeshire recording a 49% increase (+61 crimes) in contrast to the decrease of 22% (-19 crimes) recorded in Ceredigion.

The monthly figures for November 2004 are largely unchanged on the same month last year at 61 offences – an increase of 1 on November 2003 levels.

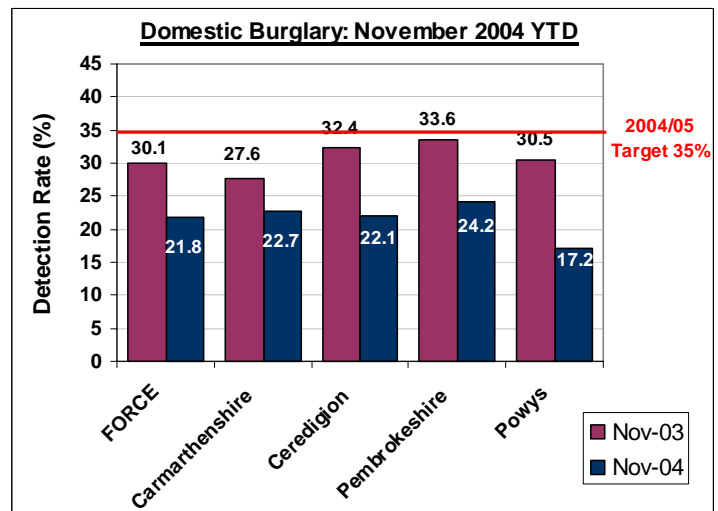


Detection Performance 2004/05

A detection rate of 22% is currently being recorded for the period April-November 2004, compared with 30% for the previous year. The volume of detections is down by 32 (-8%) to stand at 168 detections for the period.

Although subject to wide variations it is worth noting that the monthly detection performance for November stands at 18% compared with 28% for the same month in 2003.

All the divisions show a reduction in recorded performance (Apr-Nov) compared with the previous year. However, Pembrokeshire and Carmarthenshire (24% and 23%) retain the highest levels - although below the target of 35%.



Distraction Burglaries 2004/05

Recorded levels of distraction burglaries stand at 9 crimes (two detected) for the period April – November 2004, which is sixteen fewer than during the same period last year. These offences were committed in Carmarthenshire (4), Powys (3), and Pembrokeshire (2).

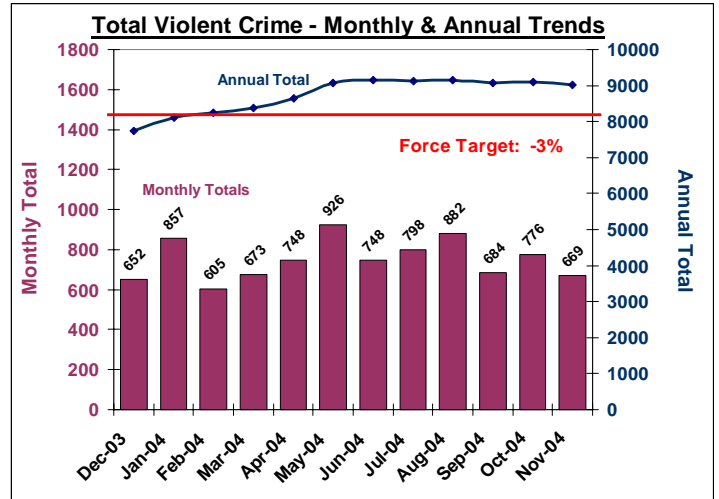
Total Violent Crime - Annual Trends

Total crimes for 2004–05 year-to-date (April–November) stand at 6,230 offences, an increase of 640 offences (+11%) compared with this time the previous year (April – November 2003).

Rates of increase vary, with a relatively large rise in Carmarthenshire of 15% (up 293 crimes) compared with little change in Ceredigion (up by 5% - 43 offences).

The number of sexual offences is recorded as 377 crimes for the period Apr–November - an increase of 94 offences (+33%) on the same period last year. Robberies stand at 26 offences – down by 8 on last year.

The levels of offences during the month November 2004 are recording a notable reduction on the same month in 2003 – with levels down by 8% (from 731 – 669 offences).



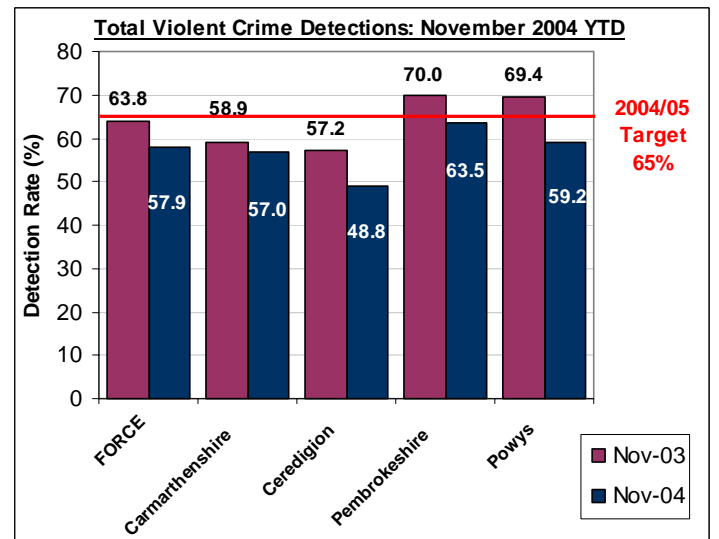
Detection Performance 2004/05 (April – November)

The detection performance stands at 58% for 2004-05. This is an apparent reduction on the on the 64% recorded for the same period last year and below the established target of 65%.

The actual volume of detections recorded is up by 1% (+41 detections) compared with the same period last year to stand at 3,606 detected violent crimes.

At divisional level Pembrokeshire are recording levels consistent with the target of 65% - but all record an apparent falling detection performance. Ceredigion and Powys record the largest reduction in detection - falling by 8 and 10 percentage points respectively.

Monthly detection performance for November 2004 stands at 60% - up from 56% in the month of November 2003.

Serious Violent Crime

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Local Target – 3% reduction in total violent crime & 65% Detection Rate

Serious Violent Crime – Sections 18, 20 & 47

This category includes assault and wounding offences covered by sections 18, 20 and 47, but excludes the crime category 105A (common assaults) Total offences stand at 2,883 for the period April - November 2004, an increase of 1.4% (+41 offences) on the previous year.

This is attributable to increases in Carmarthenshire and Pembrokeshire - up by 4% and 4% respectively. In contrast Powys is recording a 3% reduction with a 4% reduction recorded in Ceredigion.

The numbers of offences during the month of November 2004 stand at 308 – a 17% reduction on the same month in 2003 (373 offences).

Although monthly offence levels are prone to wide variations, this remains an indication that medium term trends in offences are stabilising after a period of steady increase.

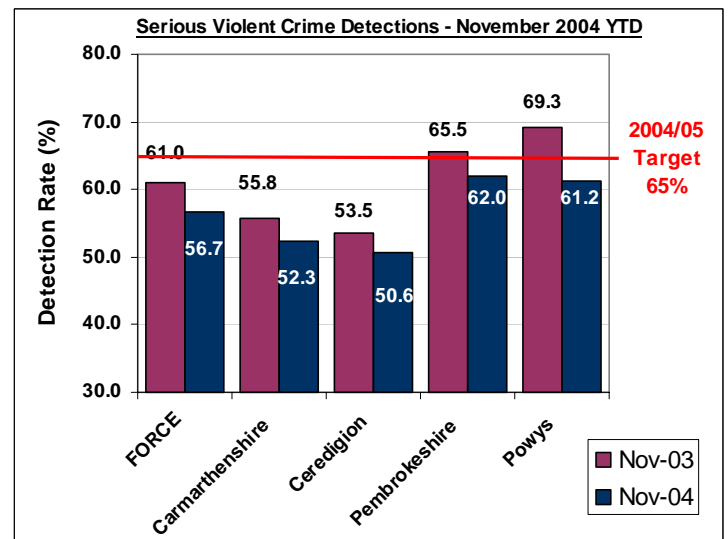
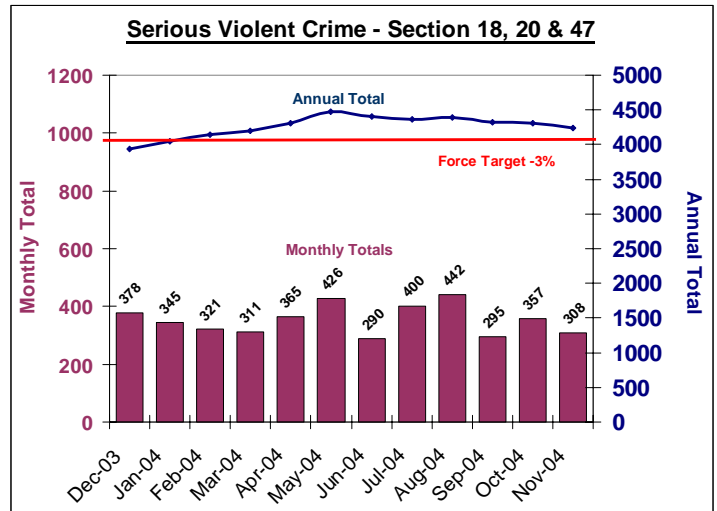
Detection Performance - Nov 2004 YTD

The period April – November 2004 records a detection rate of 57% for serious violent crime, compared to 61% achieved during the same period last year.

This fall in apparent detection performance is set against a fall in the volume of detections recorded – down by 101 detected offences (-6%) to stand at 1,632 for the period.

The fall in detection rate in Ceredigion and Powys is compounded by the notable increase in offences currently recorded in those areas.

Detection rates for serious violent crimes remain characteristically lower than those for total violent crime across the divisions.

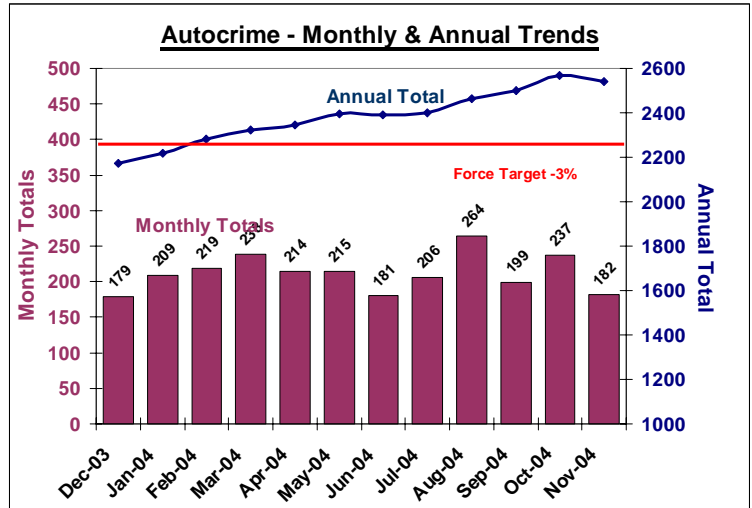
Autocrime - Annual Trends

Total offences stand at 1,698 for the period April - November 2004, an increase of 15% (+218 offences) on the previous year.

This is attributable to increases in Pembrokeshire - currently recording a 64% (+183 offences) on the same period last year.

This increase is supplemented by a 25% increase in Ceredigion offences while in contrast Carmarthenshire offences are recording a small reduction (down by 14 offences or 2%).

In addition, the monthly number of offences saw a small decrease - recording 182 in the month of November 2004 – down 12% on November 2003 (-25 offences).



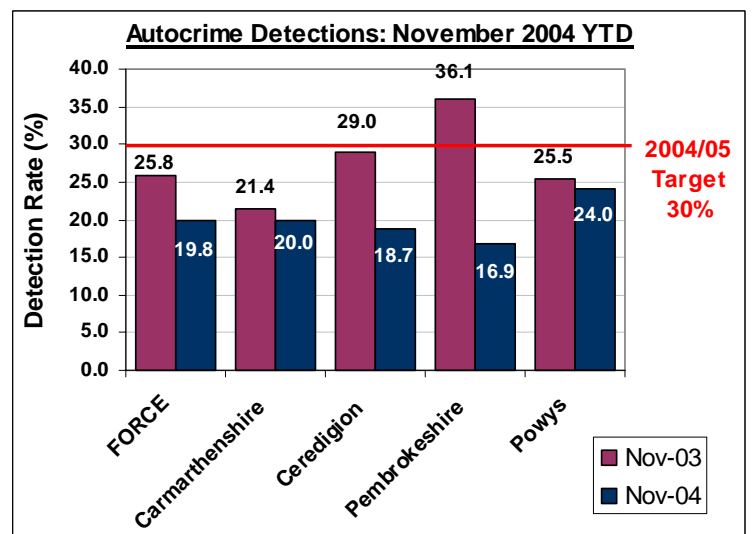
Detection Performance 2004/05

Detection performance stands at 20% for April - November 2004. This is below the target of 30% and a decrease on the 26% recorded for the same period last year.

This has been compounded over recent months by the fact that the volume of detections recorded has also fallen by nearly a quarter over the period (-12% or 45 detections).

Performance across the force is recording substantial reduction in detection – with the Pembs rate falling from 36% last year to 17% for the period April-November 2004.

Carmarthenshire is notable in recording no significant change in detection performance - with a detection rate of 21% last year compared with 20% for the period April-November 2004.

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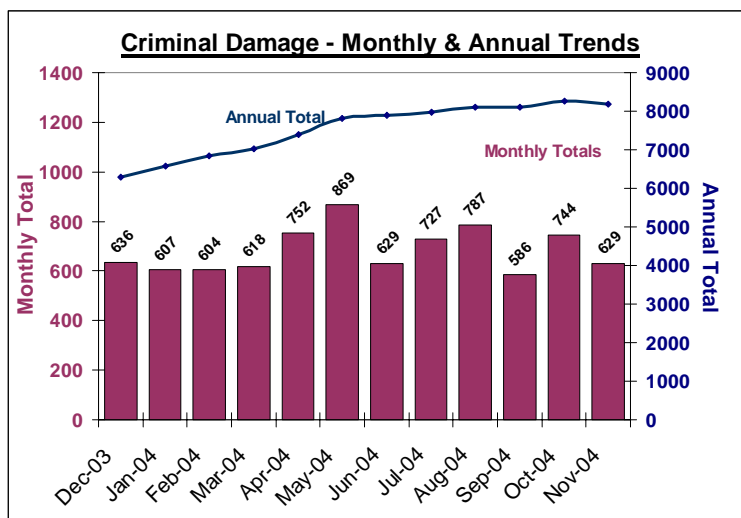

Criminal Damage - Annual Trends

A total 5,722 offences were recorded in April – November 2004, an increase of 25% in criminal damage offences (+1156 offences) compared with last year.

Increases in recorded totals remain evident across the force area, up 35% in Powys and 32% in Pembrokeshire, compounded by an increase of 27% in Carmarthenshire.

In addition, monthly offences for November 2004 stand at 629 offences, an decrease of 10% on the same month in 2003 (702 offences).



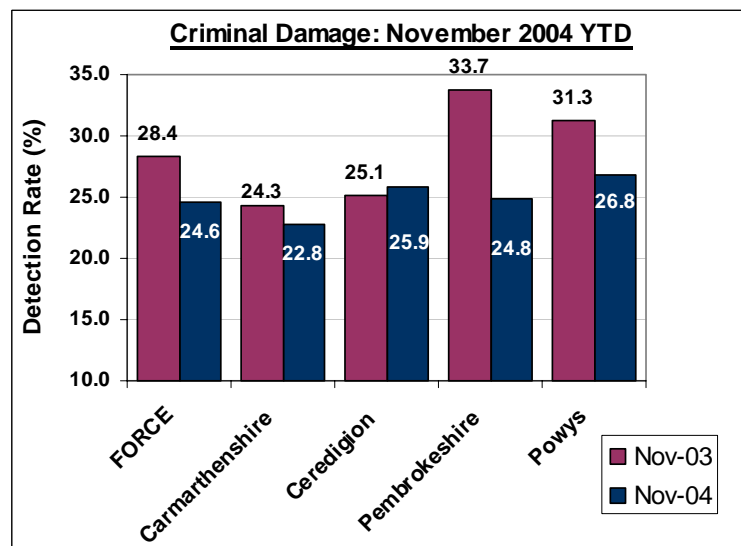
Detection Performance 2004/05

The detection rate has fallen from the previous year – standing at 25% for April - November 2004 compared with 28% for the same period last year.

Reflecting this increase, the volume of detections has correspondingly risen by 9% this year (111 more detections) to stand at 1,406 detections for the period April – November 2004.

Pembrokeshire continues to record the most pronounced reduction in recorded detection performance – down from 36% to 25%. Similarly Ceredigion remains notable in recording a slight increase from 27% – 26%.

Monthly detection performance remains broadly unchanged - standing at 22% (140 detected offences) for the month of November 2004 compared with 24% for November 2003.

Scientific Support Unit (SSU)

Scientific Support Unit (SSU) Function

The unit assists the collation and preservation of fingerprint, photographic and other forensic evidence. Following arrival at the unit the material is checked and recorded at the administration section and from here is distributed to the appropriate section within the unit.

The total number of recorded identifications for the period April-November 2004 stand at 279 - a fall of 30% (-95) on the same period last year. Correspondingly, the number of suspect searches has fallen by 32% over the period.

Of the total number of identifications for the period April-November 2004, Scientific Support Officers (SSO) completed 74%, - this compares with 74% for the same period last year. The remainder of ID's are Scene Examiner related.

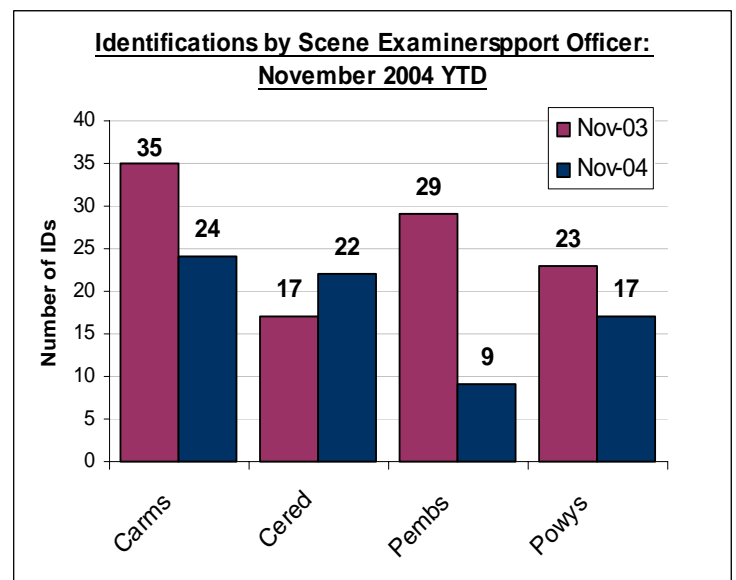
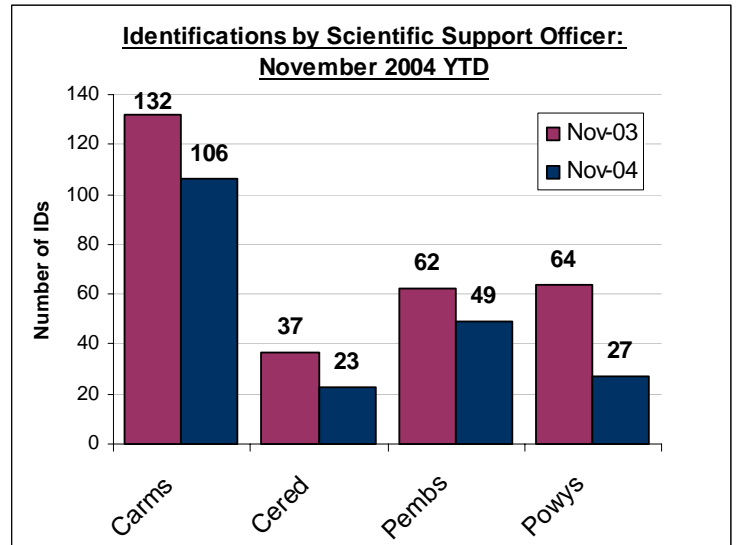
Performance for 2004-05

The total number of fingerprint development unit identifications conducted (FDU) stands at 163 for the year-to-date (227 last year) – this represents 58% of the total number of ID's (57% SPLY).

The total number of DNA matches is broadly unchanged - down from 329 SPLY. The number of DNA matches in force have increased from 65 to 83 – with a corresponding reduction in matches out of force. In contrast the number of forensic submissions are up by 12% on the previous year (from 513 to 578).

A total of 2,869 CJ samples have been received at HQ (down by 23% on period last year) - of which 89% have been sent to a laboratory for further tests. This compares with 84% for the same period last year.

As reported previously the number of rejected samples has reduced from 19 to 9. It is worth re-iterating that a number of individuals can be involved with these processes.

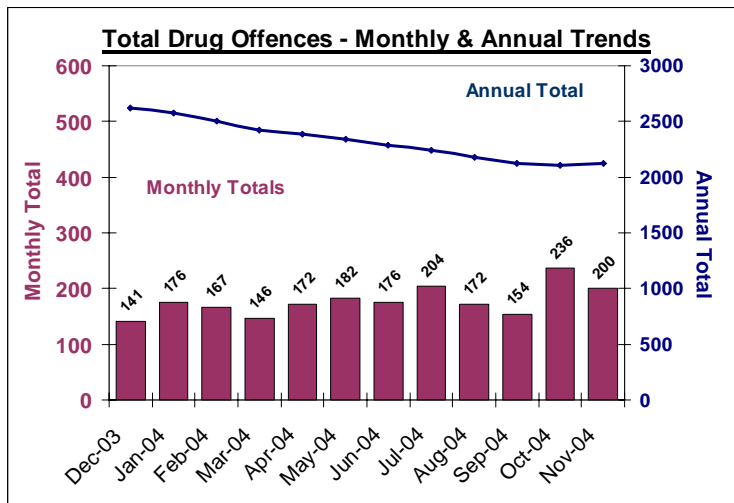
April – November 2004

All Drug Offences

The number of total drug offences for April - November 2004 stand at a total of 1497 – a 16% fall (-293 crimes) on the same period last year.

Performance at divisional level continues to show sharp variation with decreases of 49% in Powys, 9% in Carmarthenshire and 11% in Pembrokeshire.

These contrast notably with a 19% increase in Ceredigion (although this equates to an increase of only 43 offences). Trafficking offences have fallen by 30% over the period.



Drug Trafficking & Possession (2004 YTD)

- The current level of 'Trafficking in Controlled Drugs' offences stands at 24 for the period April – November 2004, a fall of 30% (-52 offences) on the same period last year.
- 'Possession of Cannabis' and 'Other Drug Possession' have fallen collectively by 21% with 1319 recorded during April–November 2004, a decrease of 287 offences. It is again notable that collective drug/Cannabis possessions in Powys are down by a nearly half this year (-52%).
- **Class A drugs (April – November 2004):**
 - The 124 trafficking offences recorded during April - November 2004, relate to 117 individual offenders (there are more offences than offenders since they may be jointly charged for the same offence).
 - There were a total of 120 offenders charged for trafficking Class-A drugs, an increase of 64 offenders on the 56 recorded for the same period last year (+114%). There have been 19 offenders charged with trafficking Cocaine (compared to 6 last year) while Heroin offenders charged now stands at 43, (up from 26 for the same period last year). Ecstasy offenders currently stand at 50 – up from 19 the previous year.

Drug Seizures

- As reported previously over previous months there is a recorded fall in the instances where drugs are seized reported during with a 25% reduction in April – November 2004 compared with the previous year (down from 2045 to 1538). While instances of seizure remain a rough measure there is also a recorded reduction in total weight and value of drugs seized.

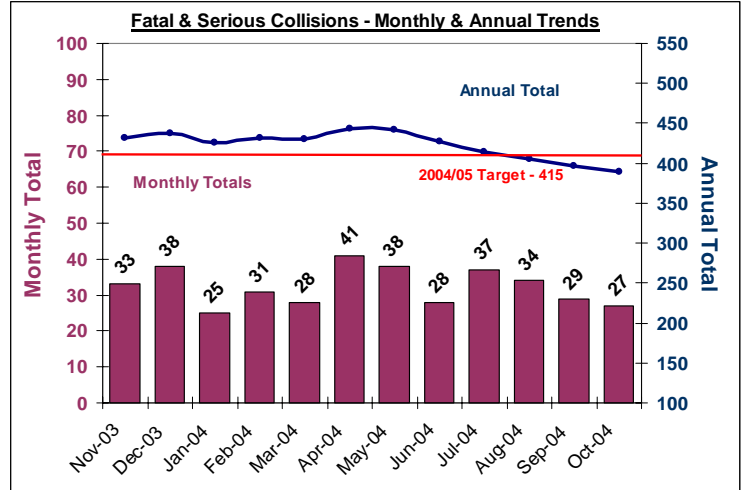
Serious and Fatal Collisions – Annual Trends

The total level of fatal collisions currently stands at 27 for April - November 2004, 5 more than the number recorded during the same period last year.

The total levels of serious and fatal collisions currently stand at 249 for April - November 2004, down by 9% on the previous year (26 fewer collisions). This is consistent with the pro-rata target for the period of 0.5 per 1,000 population.

The year ending November 2004 is currently recording a provisional total of 389 serious and fatal collisions – a 11% fall (-46 collisions) on the preceding 12-month period.

As in previous months, fatal and serious collisions have reduced by 23% in Powys and 9% in Pembrokeshire. Levels in other areas are broadly stable.

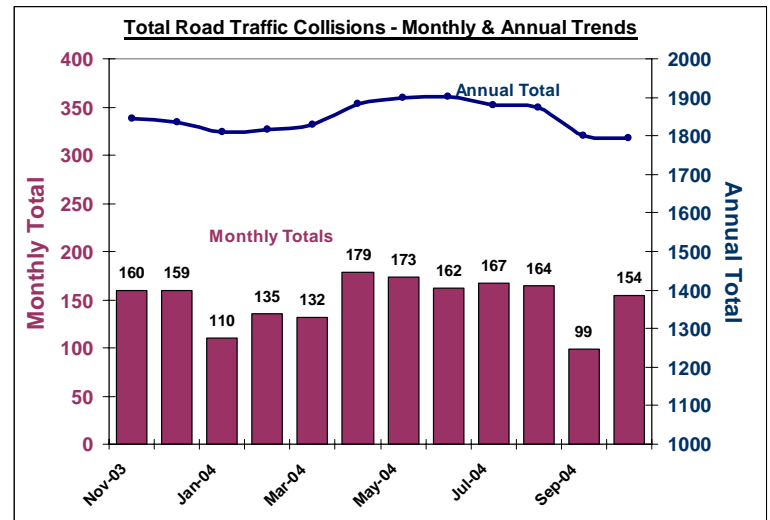


Total Road Traffic Collisions – Annual Trends

The total number of collisions (including slight) recorded during April - November 2004 stands at 1,159 – a rise of 2% (25 fewer collisions) on the same period last year.

In Carmarthenshire totals stand at 385 collisions, while totals in Pembrokeshire are down 9% (-5 collisions).

Total force area collisions for the year ending November 2004 stand at 1,794 - a fall of 2% on the preceding 12-month period (although final monthly figures are likely to negate this reduction).

Officer Sickness Levels YTD

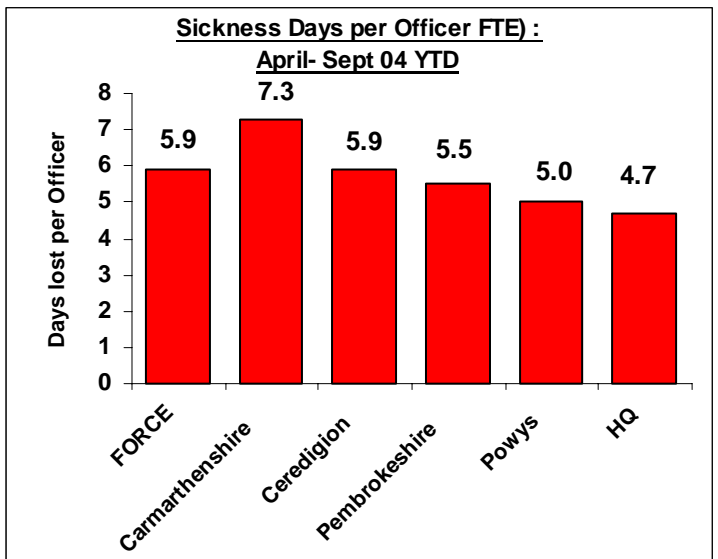
The Police Officer and Police Staff Sickness levels illustrated here are calculated using a revised methodology from September 2004.

This uses the full-time equivalent numbers of staff as rather than the previous measure that was based on a measure of headcount.

The result of this is to take into account those areas that have a large number of part-time staff. This data will be updated on a quarterly basis.

For example, officer sickness for the period April-September 2004 records a sickness level of 6.1 per officer – which using the revised measure is adjusted to 5.9.

Sickness levels stand at 5.9 days per officer (6990.5 days). At present, Carmarthenshire has the highest level with 7.3, whilst the lowest is HQ with 4.7 days is recording the greatest increase, with sickness up to 7.6 days per officer.

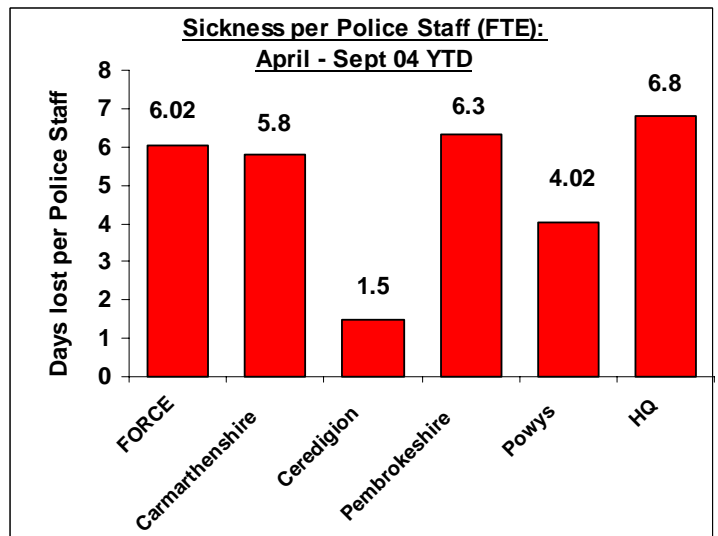


Police Staff Sickness Levels YTD

The level of recorded sickness stands at 6.02 days per police staff member for the period April – September 2004 using the full-time equivalent numbers of staff.

This compares with a total of 6.9 days per staff member using the previous headcount measure of staff. This is a greater adjustment than officers (see above) – a result of there being larger numbers of police staff working part-time.

The lowest current levels of police staff sickness stand at 1.5 days in Ceredigion, whilst the highest recorded is HQ with 6.8 days, followed by Pembrokeshire BCU with 6.3 days.

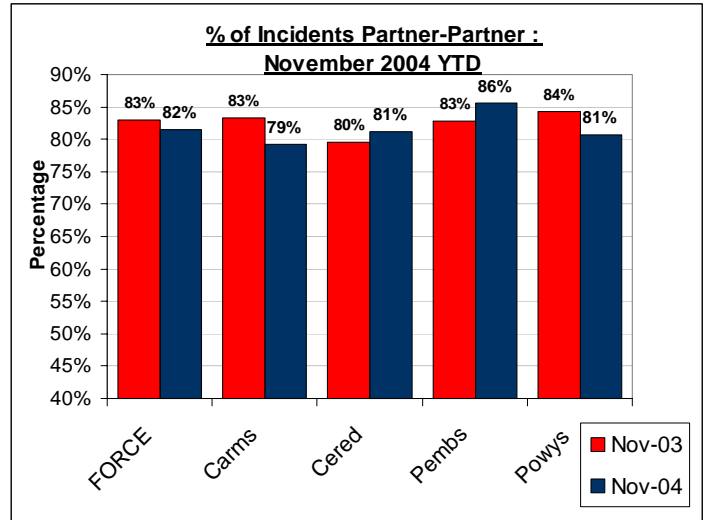

The total incidents recorded stands at 2,654 incidents for the period April-November 2004 – a 6% increase on the same period last year (+141 incidents).

Similarly, the total level of arrests arising from these incidents has fallen by 7% to stand at 789 (compared with 859 last year). The % of arrests where a power of arrest occurs is stable at 80% (this is the same as last year).

The proportion of incidents attributable to partner-partner (both current and former) conflict stands at 82% - a decrease on the 87% last year. In addition, the volume of partner related incidents has changed slightly, having fallen by 15 incidents over the period.



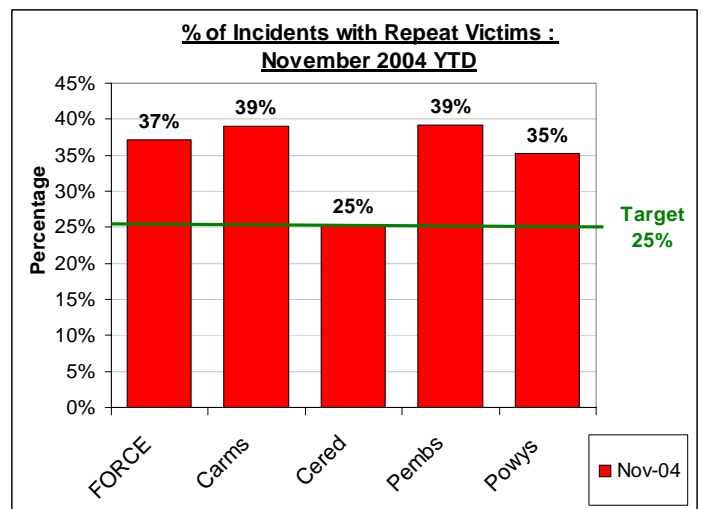
Total Repeat Domestic Incidents: Oct 2004 YTD

Among the total incidents recorded during the period April-November 37% of these involved persons who have been a victim at some other point during the preceding 12-months (approx 984 incidents).

Performance at divisional level remains characteristically lowest in Ceredigion at 25% - consistent with the desired target level of 25%.

Approximate data for the same period last year suggests increases in repeat victimisation levels are most pronounced in Carmarthenshire and Pembrokeshire.

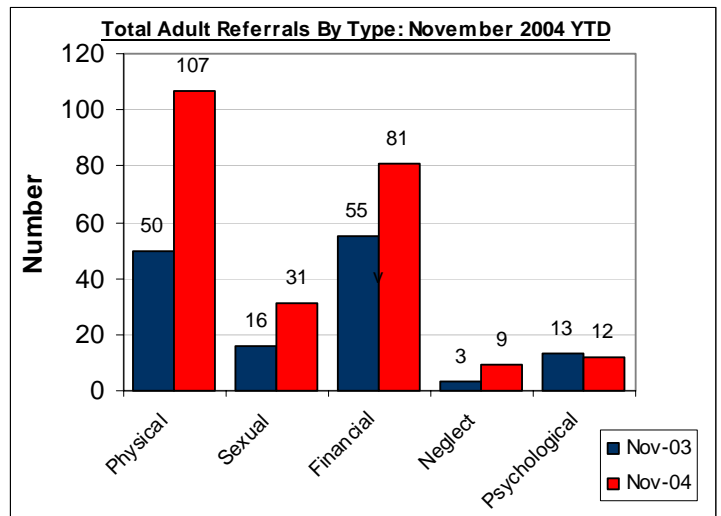
Child Referrals – November 2004 YTD

The total numbers of child referrals for April - November 2004 stands at 1087, a 19% reduction on the previous year (although current data is provisional pending data from Aberystwyth).

The majority of these referrals (73%) were for the protection of the child due to a perceived physical or sexual risk.

The number of victims interviewed on video currently stands at 212 – a level down by 24 interviews compared with same period last year.

The numbers of children detained for protection (under s. 46) stands at 148 - a reduction of 30% on the previous year.



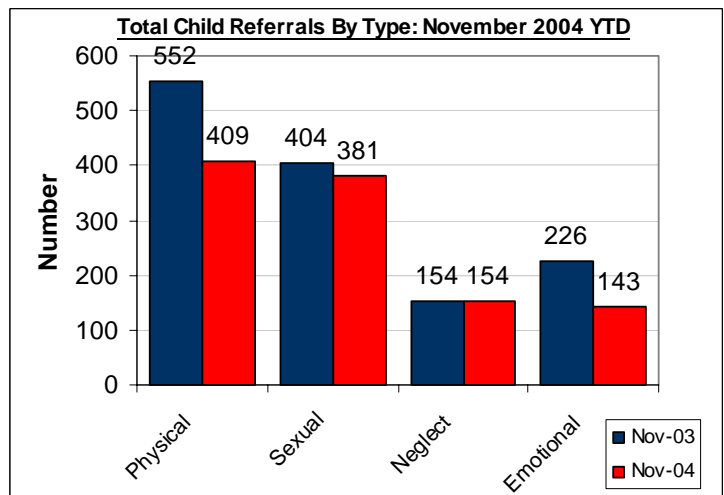
Adult Referrals & ABE - November 2004 YTD

Levels of adult referral remain lower, now recording a total of 240 for the year to date – up from 137 for the same period last year.

Physical threat remains the most common reason for adult referral – at 45% (up from 36% for the same period last year).

The numbers of witness interviews (consistent with Achieving Best Evidence) recorded on video are continuing to record a notable increase.

Adult witness video interviews have increased from 40 to 51, and child witness video interviews have increased from 175 to 212 for the same period last year.

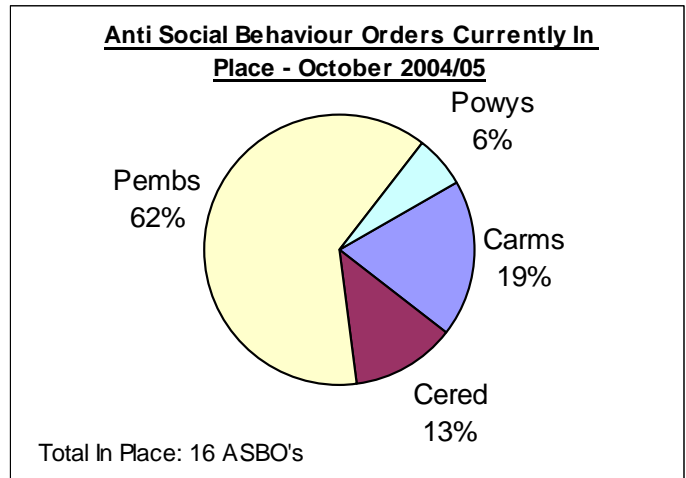
Anti-Social Behaviour Orders –November 2004 YTD

For the purposes of obtaining an ASBO the definition of anti-social behaviour requires that the defendant must be shown to have behaved in an anti-social manner and that an order is necessary for the protection of persons from further anti-social behaviour by the defendant.

There are currently a total of 16 individuals who currently are subject to an ASBO in the force area – unchanged from last month.

Of these ASBO's – 11 were due to drunkenness in a public place and of the total 5 have subsequently been convicted of breaching their order.

Please note the ASBO is not currently a record of anti-social behaviour or its severity, but rather a measure of the frequency that a specific legal action is applied.

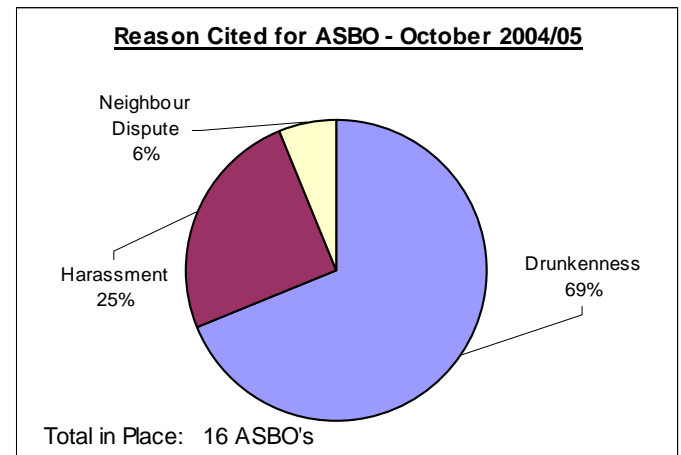


Public Disorder – Fixed Ticket Penalties

The total number of fixed penalties issued for public disorder stands at 310 – with 105 of these added during the month of November (34%).

This equates to a level of ticket penalties issued at around 0.6 per 1,000 population - rising to 0.9 in Pembrokeshire.

The total number of anti-social disorder incidents is currently standing at 21,210 for the period Apr-November YTD. The majority of these are recorded as general nuisance incidents (72%).

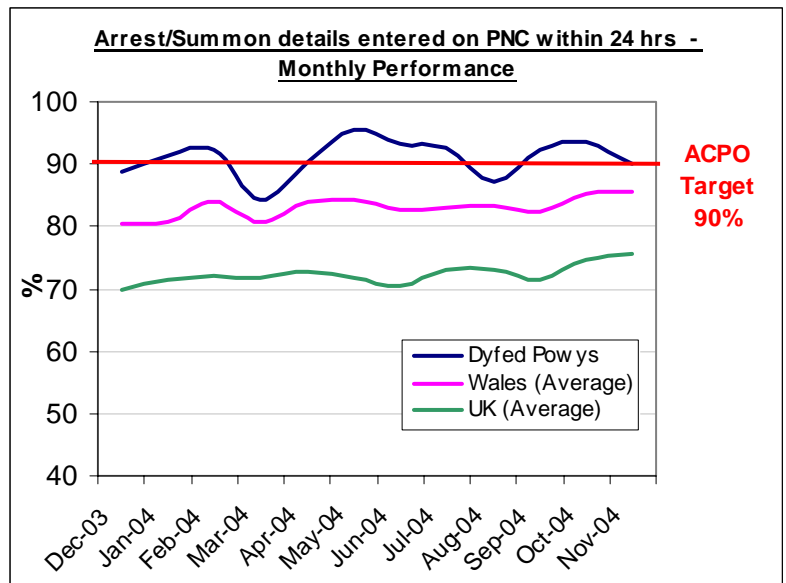

Arrest/Summons Details on PNC - Monthly

The speed at which details of arrest and summons in Dyfed Powys are entered on PNC within 24 hrs is averaging 88% each month during the period April-Nov 2004.

The actual monthly figure for November 2004 was at 90%. This monthly performance remains higher than the Welsh and UK monthly average (86% and 76% respectively) as it has been for some months.

The number of reports entered stands at a total of 7,720 for April-November 2004 – a reduction of 8% on the same period last year. This compares with an 6% increase in Wales and 15% increase across the UK.

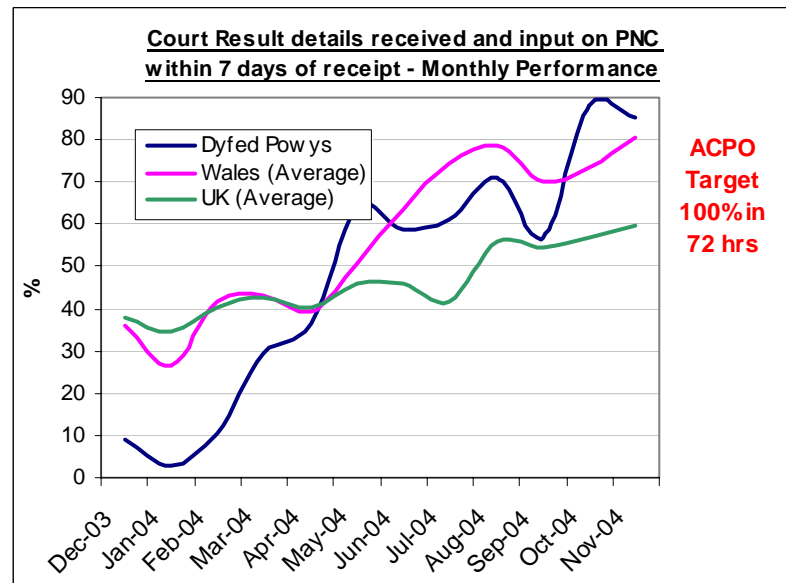


Court Result Details on PNC - Monthly

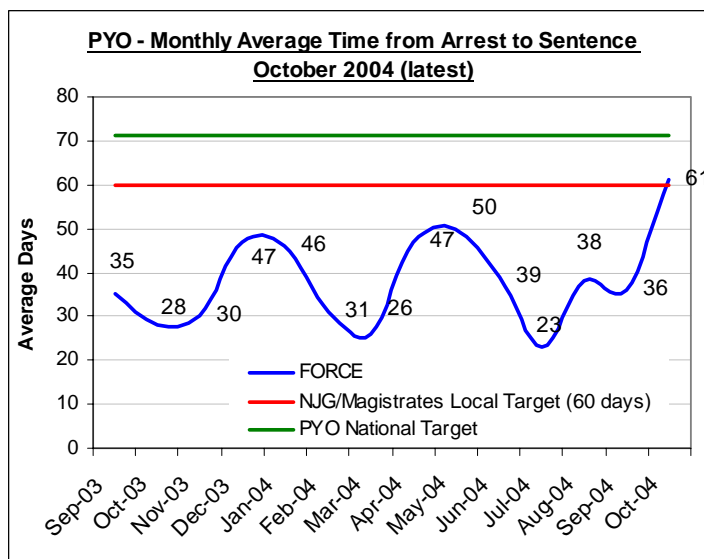
Persistent Young Offenders – November 2004

This section is aimed at providing performance information relating to the 'Narrowing the Justice Gap' (NJG) agenda and the number of offences brought to justice.

Monthly performance currently recorded for October 2004 stands at an average period of 61 days from arrest of persistent young offender to time of sentence.

This data remains provisional – but this is the first monthly level for many months that is outside of the local criminal justice board of 60 days, but nevertheless remains within the national target of 71 days.

Although case levels differ markedly, the time to completion during October (latest) was recorded as highest in Aberystwyth and Ammanford (79 days and 74 days respectively).



Offences Brought to Justice & NJG Performance

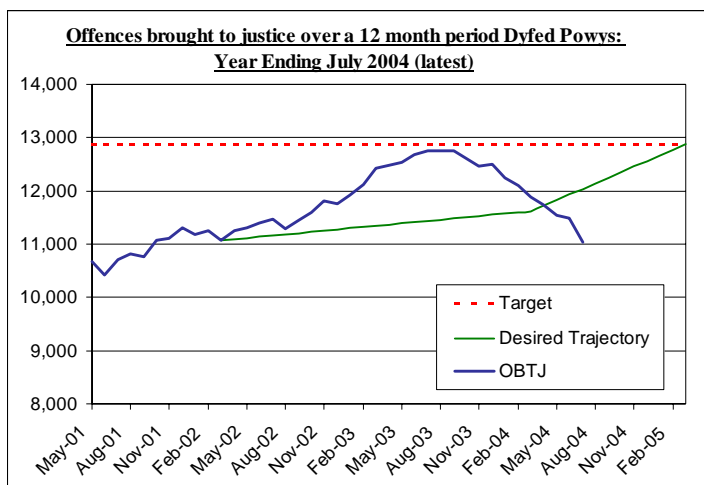
In 2001/02 a total of 11,068 offences were brought to justice (OBTJ), representing an attrition rate of 46.2% (i.e. OBTJ as a % of original recorded offences).

The figure for the period April 2003 – July 2004 (the most recently available 12-months' data) illustrates an attrition rate of 33.5%.

It represents a 0.3% reduction compared with the baseline year, against a target of a 16% increase by the end of 2004/05. However, it seems increasingly likely that the current volume target will be revised downwards by the Home Office for 2005/06.

Other NJG performance measures are illustrating a monthly ineffective trial rate for crown courts at 9% for the year ending September 2004 (target 12%), and for magistrates courts at around 10% (target 23%).

File quality targets are also being met. The force monthly figure for August 2004 stands at 84%, with year to date (Apr-August – latest) at 89% - ahead of the established target of 80% for 2004/05.

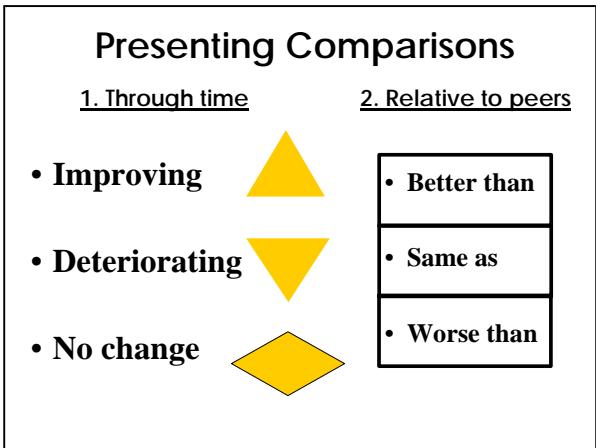
