Request:

Between the dates of 23rd March 2020 and 13th April 2020 please provide the following information:

1. The highest recorded speed by a driver within the force area that you police?
2. What was the speed limit of the section of road where this speed was detected?
3. On what stretch of road and at what time of day was this speed recorded?
4. How many drivers were caught exceeding a 30mph limit in your force?
5. How many drivers were caught exceeding a 20mph limit in your force?
6. How many drivers were issued with a penalty for doing non-essential journeys in contravention of the Government's lockdown instructions?

Clarification:

- I'm looking specifically for individuals stopped while in their vehicles and receiving a PCN for non-compliance with lockdown rules.
- I was looking for both – numbers caught speeding in 30mph limit areas and 20mph limit areas separately. And again separately the numbers of individuals stopped for COVID 19 reasons.
- To clarify Q6 relates to drivers only for breaking lockdown instructions.

Responses 1 - 3:

I can confirm that Dyfed-Powys Police does hold the information requested, as outlined below.

Please note: Dyfed-Powys Police only record individuals stopped by a police officer for speeding offences therefore this response does not include individuals caught speeding by a mobile or fixed speed camera.
